Can’t take either start at face value. She was on the lead in the debut but came to a walk in a race that was moved off the turf. Likely bled last out. Ownership moved her to Todd Pletcher who had the multiple graded stakes winning grass sib Emmanuel. Gets first Lasix. Jose Ortiz adds to the appeal.

Value: 8 Candy Landy

Won three back but was DQ’d for leaning out. Didn’t like a very sloppy track in the stakes two back. Thought the pace last time out was very quick and she rightly tired late after pressing it early. Female line of G1 turf runner Radiant Ring who won many turf route stakes. 3 works since the last out.

Been in the money in all 7 starts. He’s been very unlucky to not have won. He lost photo finishes in the last two and 2nd by less than a length in the two prior. Was just tagged by the eventual G3 Holy Bull winner 3 back. Winner two back won again and then was nosed out in the Hutcheson here.

Value: 9 Migratory

Took soon to judge this one. He’s had just one start, on the turf sprinting at AQU, and he lagged far behind before late action passing some runners. Adds Lasix and get blinkers added. Been working consistently for this and attracts top rider Rosario. Dam won \$1.5M sprinting on turf. Looks live.

He had a very big year as a 3YO. He was 7 for 7 in the money and won the G1 Belmont Derby (for 3YO’s only). Big effort when beaten just a half in the rich Dueling Grounds Derby last time out. Switches back to Clement who had him for the first two starts (both wins here). Layoff is the only issue.

Value: 3 Lucky Score

Just like the top choice, this one is making his return in this spot. Both horses likely have bigger targets down the road so it will come down to which connections have their horse keyed up more. Fairly lightly raced for a 6YO gelding. Toss the last start when breaking from a tough rail and in traffic.

This is the Personal Ensign female family. She was the ’88 champion, undefeated filly who tagged Ky Derby winner Winning Colors in the BC Distaff. Both races were excellent for this Clement colt. Winner of debut was just 4th here on Sat in the Fla Derby. Winner of last a firster for Chad Brown.

Value: 6 Derby Street

Third dam is Quiet Dance. She is the dam of \$4.4M earner and superstar Saint Liam. Is also the dam of Quiet Giant the dam of \$16M earner, and champion, Gun Runner. The pedigree is there. Mott is probably better known for giving them a race (3 for 49 in debut MSW dirt routes). Check tote.

Winner of two of her last three starts. The lone defeat in the last three races came two back when she didn't break well as her head was turned as the gates opened but she rallied well for third. Beat many of these in those starts. Trainer is having a decent meet. This is likely his barn star right now.

Not a bad spot for a recent maiden winner. She dropped to maiden claiming 25k and was much the best in the victory last time out. Don't think she loved being on the rail in the start two back. That required aggressive rider Paco Lopez to use her to hold position running into pretty fast fractions.

This is 1 of 2 in the race for high percentage trainer Saffie Joseph. This one looked great winning his second start on this track and then back to back runner-up finishes at this same level. He was favored in the last start but was really hindered in the race when checked. New rider Lopez is up.

Have a hard time believing the last start was true indicator of his talent. His prior 5 starts had speed figures that are good enough to win this race. Was a 7-1 runner-up 2 back in a stronger race. For whatever reason, he just didn't have it last time out. Rosario up and he is 1 for 1 riding for Hess.

Seems to be a grass sprinter and is 5 for 7 in the top two on the turf. Lone start on this turf was a runner-up at 1M vs. same about a year ago.

Value: 10 Qualy

Not quite sure if he's good enough to beat these but if not, he isn't far off. The last two starts are not representative of his potential in here. He was eliminated in last when he hit the rail from a terrible inside draw. Trouble also occurred in the start 2 back. Wide post might help his chances here.

She ran very well in both starts. She drew the rail, a tough spot at 7.5F on this turf if you don't have good early speed. It cost her as she hit the rail and had to angle out for a run. 8 path in the debut but finished with something at that 5F distance. 1st and 3rd from there are stakes caliber runners.

Value: 6 Pipit

Trainer Michael Matz has 5 wins and 9 in the money from his last 16 debut turf routers in MSW company. The winning odds ranged between 5-1 and 15-1. Love the work pattern for this debut. The last four works were all on the grass at Palm Beach Downs. Pa-bred looks well-meant in this spot.
