

ON THIS DATE (2000) – CROCROCK has the record for most money earned at Canterbury by a Mn-bred. On August 20, 2000, Crocrock won the Minnesota Sprint Stakes for the first time. He would win that race again in 2001, 2002 and 2004 making him a 4-time sprint champion. He finished second by a neck in the same Mn Sprint Stakes in 2003.

She registered the groups top Beyer in that race. Notice how 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> were all spread out behind her. Should get a comfortable trip.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 1 COASTLINE SERMON</b><br/>Was on turf in last and that doesn't look like the surface he wants. Was beaten by the top choice by just half a length in the start two back. Has speed but could rate if Harr decides to do that. He's made 100k here.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 8 BLUE JEANS N BEER</b><br/>Was 9-1 going long in last but broke slowly and then watched a Diodoro dropper crush by nearly 11. Mn-bred ran well in the 3 prior starts, all on the board. Just like top choice, he could get a perfect trip. Hit the board in 11 of 18 on this dirt course.
