RULER ON ICE away in good order, moved up willingly into a forward position, sat perched just to the outside of the pacesetter, contently stalked that rival withthe rider sitting with a firm hold on the reins, gradually ranged up departingthe backstretch, moved when ready as the pair neared the head of the stretch, forged to the front during the run through the furlong grounds, but with several foes still in hot pursuit, then dug in with good determination to prevail. STAY THIRSTY patiently tracked the front runners from the two path under a firm hold, stayed within good striking distance down the backstretch, was guided over to the rail at the half mile, picked up the pace under some encouragement from the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner under stronger handling and took off in earnest after the front runners, closed in with good energy to loom boldly at the eighth pole, could gain no additional ground but continued on with good courage to garner place honors. NEHRO darted over to the inside, tucking along the rail a few strides before reaching the first turn, saved ground until the quarter pole, angled out entering the stretch and rallied mildly to improve position.SHACKLEFORD out broke the field, angled sharply over towards the inside, was rated on the front end, alternating between the two and three path, under the watchful eye of RULER ON ICE , was put to encouragement as the
