Sibling Airoforce won the G3 Bourbon at KEE in his second start and has won nearly 700k on the grass. Deep in the female family is the multiple G1 winner, Sea Cadet. Works say she is ready.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 READY TO BATTLE Sire won the G1 Preakness on dirt and the G1 Makers Mark Mile on the turf. Sib to the 5YO Joe who took a 100k at PIM on the turf in 2022. Mark Casse won 8 of 60 starts with 2YO turfer in the debut going long (13%). Casse off to a sizzling start at the meet (6 of 16, 38%). She stretched out the next start and no blinkers. It produced a huge show finish beaten just a neck at 15-1 in there. Wide trip from the 12 post in the last start but won it was the favorite. Dam was a graded stakes placed runner for this ownership five years ago.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 IMMERSIVE Brad Cox first timer. He has hit the board in 19 of 35 (54%) with a debut dirt sprinter in MSW for Godolphin (5 winners).
