

ON THIS DATE (1987) – On June 27, 1987, the day before Lost Code won the St. Paul Derby, TAPPIANO won the 3rd running of the Canterbury Oaks (which would become the Curtis Sampson Oaks). Tappiano was already a three-time G1 winner before the Oaks win. She won 17 of 34 starts in her career and earned over \$1.3M for Minnesotan Frances Genter.

He was 17-1 in the first time Valenzuela was aboard. Winner two back won by 4 vs open allw foes and looks like a future stakes winner. Ran well going a mile a few times last year. Big late run today.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 SILVER DASH Definitely bred to go long. Dam won at 1M 3/8 in her career. Sire won the Pimlico Special at 1M 3/16 and was a G1 winner. Awkward start in the 6F sprint last out but he was getting to the top two late. Probably haven't seen his best. Eikleberry got up in last (rode him many times here previously) and it produced a run and hide win at 8-5. He's run well on an off-track so the move off the turf will help him. Eikleberry is up.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 FULLBRIDLEDPHANTOM He's run well on both turf and dirt so. Won his most recent start on the turf for fun over a decent group for that level. Second to Shinnny four back at TUP at 5-1. He was gaining on that one late. He can finish strongly but has shown tactical speed. Other is the one right to his outside. Exits a key race 2 back. 3rd and 7th both won back (allw and opt clm). 8th ran 2nd at AZD in an allw for Justin Evans. Think he'll send more than his other one. Mn-bred is 3x stakes placed.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 NILES CHANNEL Shipper from Prairie Meadows when he was last 3rd in a strong 30k claiming race. The winner won back in a 33k allowance at PRM at 3-1 (80 Beyer). He takes a cut in distance and will have to overcome a track that caters to speed. This one took no betting action, got a poor start and was 6-wide on the turn. He did pass some runners to get 4th in there. Rider move to Canchari (is doing well lately).</p> <p>VALUE: 5 GRAPHYTE Ran in spots splitting the field in the JP warrior blow out win. He did beat 6 runners in the similar spot at Lone Star 3 back on the turf at 22-1. He was inside in that one, as well, and shuffled back at a key spot in that race. He was a game second to Dame Plata in the recent start. He was really hurt having to run head to head with Mr. Jagermeister. Dame Plata got a dream trip but this one stayed on gamely. Might rate a bit here.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 NET GAIN Deep closer is making his first start of the year. 9YO has won 4 of 8 at the distance and he projects to get a perfect pace situation today. There are many that might go out early and set it up for his late run. He's likely to be overlooked. But we'll stick with him on the move to the dirt. He isn't facing a strong field and if he handles the dirt he should be live. Stumbled at the start in last and really lost all chance. Will show more speed in here.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 MY GOLDEN BOY Comes out of the same race as the top choice. Was 26-1 in there and beat just one home. He has a few decent starts on the dirt. Hit the board in two races on dirt at ARP in MSW company at longer odds. Has a sharp 4F dirt drill since last. Will save ground here.</p> <p>A) 2,7 B) 1,4 C) 3</p> |

PICK: 3 MORE THAN A. P.
 He's spent 17 of his 23 races on the grass and of the 6 times he was on the dirt, half of those were on an off-track. Good run three back on fast dirt. 2nd place finisher went to Lone Star and ran second by a half in a 30k claiming race. Notice Juarez was up in there.

PICK: 1 CHICKS DIG SCARS
 Can draw a line through his last start. Added blinkers in there and stretched out to a route. Blinkers come off today and cuts right back to a sprint. Turf was the main question but it now moves to the dirt. Handled off-tracks quite well. Top rider up. Value play in here.

VALUE: 2 SIDE STREET DAVE
 Thought the 10k claimer he exits was a strong group top to bottom. The winner was running well in open class allowance at Delta previously. Runner-up was close in opt clm at TUP prior and then won another 10k claim here easily (77 Beyer). Toss into the exotics.

VALUE: 4 EL TIZAR
 That was quite a nice effort at 5F last out. The winner is a nice looking runner who set the track record for 5F in that win. This one made up a lot of ground on a turf that was favoring speed. Best races have been on the turf but did win a MSW on dirt in debut at CD.
