PICK: 6 FLYNN'S CHANCE She split the field won by a stablemate who came back to crush in her second start next out in the G1 Del Mar Deb. 5 th won a MSW at LRC by 11 next. She has a couple of siblings that were graded stakes placed. Mandella 4 for last 10 2nd timer in MSW sprint to route.			PICK: 6 LEGISLATOR He actually beat winners at Del Mar 2 back but was DQ'd from shifting out. Proved that wasn't a fluke when a close 2 nd against that same level last out. He came from far back to just miss in there. Drops back into MSW company for Peter Miller who is at 25% here.			PICK: 5 SUPER CHIEF Really stands out in here. He's run 4 times and all 4 are good enough to win this. Winner of last won for fun next out vs. opt clm with an 89 Beyer. Two others from that race won next and 3 more in the money next. He gets a big rider change. Has a sizzling 10/3 work.	
VALUE: 3 DE JORIA Claimed out of the last start. The 5 th place in that last race is better than it may look. She was buried down on the rail and found a bit of traffic before exploding late. Should see enough speed to set up a late run. Like her better off the inside. Kent D stays up today.			VALUE: 2 TIANMA She comes out of the same key race as the top choice and was actually some 7 lengths in front of that one. She did have the benefit of a race under her belt. Bred to go long with Distorted Humor on the top, Empire Maker on the bottom. O'Neill having a decent meet.			VALUE: 4 HULA CANDY He's run four times and had four miserable trips. Off very slow in the debut. Poor start 3 back and then tried to close into slow early fractions. Checked as the favorite two back and was beaten less than two lengths to the one who beat the top choice in his last start.			VALUE: 2 SEATTLE BREAKOUT Comes out of the same two races the choice in here, Super Chief, comes out of. He was climbing in both of those races. Actually did come on pretty well despite a wide trip two back. Drops weight with the apprentice. He will get some pace to close into. Underneath.

PICK: 1 NOT A SINNER She was sent off at 16-1 in the debut in IRE back in July. She gamely tacked on late for a good third place finish (beating 8). Trainer has a win, 2 nd and 3 rd with 5 Euro shippers in the last two years (win was ridden by same rider Rispoli). Well-spaced worktab for this.			PICK: 3 CHAOS REIGNS He exits quite the key race. 1 st , 2 nd , 4 th , 5 th , 6 th and 8 th place finishers all won their next start. Winner won an opt clm by over 7 with an 86 Beyer. Fired 4 strong works since the last start. Blinkers on and adds a major jock for this (Rispoli). Expect him to show speed.			PICK: 2 KLEEN KARMA Beat open 40K claimers at 26-1 last out. She didn't break on time in the last 3 starts for Craig Lewis. Now with Leonard Powell, if she can get out of the gate, she could be sitting in the all-important second spot behind the rail runner. Third in this race at 11-1 in 2022.			PICK: 3 A NEW PEACE She's only been under the 20K claiming tag 4 times winning 2 of them. Third from most recent start beat males in a 20K allw at Los Al at night at 6-1. Not much speed in here so she could be closer to the front then normal today. She looks awfully tough at this level.	
VALUE: 9 CAILIN DANA Dam was a nice runner in her day. She was a close third in a G3 in her third career start on this turf course going 1M 1/8. She might have been too close to the fast pace in that stakes at Del Mar last out. She rightfully got tired in the late stages. Debut was very good.			VALUE: 5 EMERALD UNION He was actually just a couple of lengths off of the top choice two back from a difficult inside post. Added blinkers in last and then got away slowly before making an early run to the front. He then tired quickly. Worked 3 times since then. Another look at this level.			VALUE: 1 ORGANIC Unless someone really changes their style, this filly should be all alone up front. Forget her last start when she got into trouble. She went wire to wire in the previous two after the blinkers came off. Might be a cut below these classwise but race flow gives her a shot.			VALUE: 8 EQUILOVE Don't love playing runners like this. She has not finished a race in a long time and hasn't even run in a year. But there is almost zero speed in the race and she could find herself on the lead. Notice she did win right off the bench twice before. All or nothing up front.

Race calls for those who have started for a tag of 50k and haven't won 3 times. This one started for that 50k price just once (which was 14 starts ago). Rider Ayuso gets back up and he rode this one for the last win (at GG in April). Should sit perfectly stalking today.

VALUE: 5 AURELIAN MAN

Lone starter at the meet was this 5YO back in late September and it produced a 9-2 win on this turf. That is one of two wins in 2023 for this trainer. Figures to come from off of the pace here and that is a good thing given the speed here. Bottled up in traffic 2 back.

VALUE: 1 GHAZAALY

Major rider upgrade. Since he came off the two-year layoff, he's had apprentice riders aboard. Berrios was working him in the AM and is off the top choice to stay here. Good effort at 5-1 in last. Stakes, turf and a major steady in 3 of the prior 4. He won the other.

Can't find a legitimate excuse for the poor run last out. Prior to that, he was solid. Toss the G3 without Lasix 3 back. He won one and was second in the other three in the 4 starts prior. Might not be ideal distance but he will get plenty of pace to close into. Drop helps.

VALUE: 8 TIZ PLUS

Nothing cheap about the win last time out for Mike Puype. He went up and set very fast fractions and kept grinding away for the win at 3-1. Claimed from there probably for this spot as he's 9 for 14 in the money at 1M on the turf. Faced better. Should stalk the pace.
