LEMON DROP KID, away well and close up three wide while well in hand, raced just outside of the front runners on the backstretch, advanced three wide on the second turn, dug in resolutely when set down turning for home and bested VISION AND VERSE after a long struggle. VISION AND VERSE moved up quickly to prompt the pace, gained a short lead approaching the stretch and fought it out gamely along the inside through the stretch. MENIFEE, taken in hand after the start and checked while a bit rank along the inside early on, raced behind horses along the backstretch and into the turn, advanced inside on the second turn, came wide in upper stretch and finished gamely from the outside. ECTON PARK, rated along between rivals, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and stayed on well outside. BEST OF LUCK, outrun early, was hustled along on the backstretch, picked it up a bit on the second turn, came wide into the stretch but could not gain in the drive. BADGER GOLD, rated along inside, saved ground on both turns but had no response when roused. CAT THIEF quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. UNBRIDLED JET raced wide, drifted into the stretch and tired.
