Risen Star reached contention while saving ground racing into the first turn, was allowed to follow the leaders while remaining well out from the rail through the run down the backstretch, moved through inside Forty Niner and Winning Colors to take over approaching the five-sixteenths pole, came out while drawing clear into the stretch and was roused to hold **Brian's Time** safe.

The latter, outrun early, moved through inside horses at the far turn, came out to continue his rally approaching the stretch and finished with good courage between Risen Star and Winning Colors.

Winning Colors went right after Forty Niner, raced outside that rival while prompting the pace to the far turn, was still prominent when she ducked to the inside of Risen Star soon after entering the stretch, then wasn't good enough while continuing to lug in.

Private Terms raced within easy striking distance until near the stretch but lacked a rally. **Cefis**, badly outrun, passed tired horses while making up some ground late.

Regal Classic, unhurried while saving ground into the backstretch, came out approaching the far turn but failed to be a serious factor. **Forty Niner** showed speed from the outset, remained well out in the track while making the pace, held on well until near the stretch and gave way.

Sorry About That moved up along the inside approaching the end of the backstretch but lacked a further response. **Finder's Choice**, sent after the leaders while racing wide into the first turn, raced forwardly into the backstretch but was finished after going 5 furlongs.
