<b>1 – TURFWAY PARK (3:00 ET) 44</b> <b>MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 100K, 6F SYNTHETIC</b>  <b>7 GAME DAY 7-2</b> 2 CONSOLIDATED 12-1 9 DISMISS 3-1 4 SHALLUS 12-1  <b>PICK: 7 GAME DAY</b> <b>VALUE: 2 CONSOLIDATED</b> A) 2,7,9 B) 4,5,8 C) 3,6 D) 1,11		<b>3 – TURFWAY PARK (4:00 ET) 53</b> <b>OPTIONAL CLAIMING 104K, 1M 1/4 SYNTHETIC</b>  <b>10 TIZ HER MONEY 3-1</b> 2 GOLDEN SUNSHINE 2-1 1 ROYAL JUSTICE 15-1 5 DISCO RULES 6-1  <b>PICK: 10 TIZ HER MONEY</b> She's proven on synthetic having both of her wins on it so far. She closed resolutely in most of her starts. Was a 7-1 longshot place finisher in the G3 Selene four back. It was a good effort having to go very wide in there. Pace in the last start was a bit on the slow side which left her too much to overcome late. Distance is no issue for this filly.  <b>VALUE: 1 ROYAL JUSTICE</b> Can never discount a runner who likes to win. This is an Indiana bred 3YO filly who has 4 wins in her last 6 starts. She won a 100k Ind-bred stakes by over 6-lengths 2 back at 23-1. Rider Bermudez has been aboard her 3 times so far. He won all 3. Certainly gets a serious class test on the track switch and move up from facing mostly statebreds. A) 2,10 B) 1,3,5,6 C) 7,9 D) 4		<b>4 – TURFWAY PARK (4:30 ET) 35</b> <b>MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 100K, 1M 1/16 SYNTHETIC</b>  <b>9 RHAPSODY IN MOTION 12-1</b> 2 BEACH BALLAD 5-2 10 PETRONELLA 3-1 5 MALANYA 10-1  <b>PICK: 9 RHAPSODY IN MOTION</b> Thought she ran well from a tough inside post in a field of 12 at CD last out. She ended up having to go 5-wide there but surged up to the front and hung in gamely to the end. Toss the start two back when she had to check in a trouble filled trip. Caught some key races and good runners in the starts previously. Low percentage rider ensures a big price.  <b>VALUE: 5 MALANYA</b> Of the top 6 finishers from the debut run at KEE going 5.5F on the turf, 5 have come back to run. Of those 5, 4 won the next start including the winner who took a 150k stakes on the grass at AQU. No disgrace 5 <sup>th</sup> stretching out at CD last out. Was beaten just over 4 there. <b>5 – TURFWAY PARK (5:00 ET)</b> <b>ALLOWANCE 103K, 1M SYNTHETIC</b> <b>35</b> <b>3 URBAN PLANNER</b> 10-1 6 BIG TO DO 5-1 8 WELAKA 7-2 9 SIESTA KEY 6-1 <b>PICK: 3 URBAN PLANNER</b> He had absolutely no chance in the last start. He was off at 45-1 and sat second to last behind fractions that went :35 and :49. He moves back to synthetic where he is 3 for 3 so far. He is 2 for 3 on this track with the only loss being in the 240k Rushaway last March. Trainer Eoin Harty is 2 for 2 to start this meet. Will move forward 2 <sup>nd</sup> off the shelf. <b>VALUE: 6 BIG TO DO</b> He comes into this off a nice 4-1 win on the turf at CD for 80k claiming. He did benefit from setting an uncontested lead in reasonable fractions. He had a win and a show on this track from three starts last winter. The win for trainer at this meet came with Ramos riding. Should press early but can sit off the lead. Big chance in a very tough event. A) 3,6,8,9 B) 5,11 C) 4,10 D) 2,12	<b>6 – TURFWAY PARK (5:30 ET)</b> <b>MY CHARMER 250K, 1M SYNTHETIC</b> <b>56</b> <b>9 SHE'S LOOKIN LUCKY</b> 8-1 3 LITERATE 7-2 2 CAITLINHERGRTNESS 7-5 8 NEXT UP 10-1 <b>PICK: 9 SHE'S LOOKIN LUCKY</b> Pretty game mare. She's only won 3 of 22 starts but been in the money 14 of 22 times and earned nearly 600k. She ran second last out to the comeback winner of the 289k Cardinal at CD. Really outran the poor trip she had when in a tough spot on the rail two back at KD. She's handled no Lasix a few times. Is plenty of pace to close into today. <b>VALUE: 8 NEXT UP</b> 3YO filly faced older twice. She was second in both with one of them being in the EP Turf three back. The 3YO turf filly division was quite strong this year so the move into a stakes for older runners isn't a problem. She's been in the money in 6 of 7 and actually broke her maiden here in the debut when claimed. Sneaky-good trainer in play. A) 2,3,9 B) 4,8 C) 5,7 D) 10	<b>7 – TURFWAY PARK (6:00 ET)</b> <b>HOLIDAY INAGURAL 250K, 6F SYNTHETIC</b> <b>37</b> <b>4 LITHE SPIRIT</b> 10-1 2 ELLEN JAY 7-2 3 PONDERING 5-2 9 NICE AS PIE 8-1 <b>PICK: 4 LITHE SPIRIT</b> 4 consecutive wins last winter, 3 over this Turfway Park surface. Her last 2 starts were subpar, beating only two home last out and none in the prior race. Asmussen returns to her regular rider, who was aboard for all three Turfway wins. 3-for-4 on synthetic, and Asmussen is 21% off a layoff into sprint stakes. Is training steadily for return. <b>VALUE: 9 NICE AS PIE</b> She's been going back and forth between turf and synth. Overall, she's won all 5 of her starts on the synthetic and all came here at Turfway Park. Cuts back significantly in distance which will put her far back early here. She does have class to compete but would need a pace meltdown to win today. This trainer is having a nice season in 2025. A) 2,3,4 B) 6,7,9,10 C) 1 D) 5
<b>8 – TURFWAY PARK (6:30 ET)</b> <b>PRAIRIE BAYOU 250K, 1M SYNTHETIC</b> <b>64</b> <b>3 CAMEO PERFORMANCE</b> 9-2 9 OTAGO 15-1 12 ENCINO 3-1 2 HORSEPOWER 8-1 <b>PICK: 3 CAMEO PERFORMANCE</b> Very dangerous team of Brendan Walsh and Irad Ortiz. He has been on synthetic 3 times and hit the board in all 3 of those starts. Thought he was traveling best late in the G3 Autumn at WO last time out but just got started too late to get there. Irad rode him to a 15-1 third place finish 7 back in a G2 at FG beaten less than one. Best deep closer in here. <b>VALUE: 9 OTAGO</b> It appears the pace in this one will be fast. This is a closer who makes his first start on synthetic after running all 20 races on the turf. Goes back to Beschizza. He rode him in 8 of his 20 starts. Trainer off to a slow start at this meet but is normally pretty high percentage. His best shot in here is to get pace meltdown and run by late. Good price. A) 3 B) 2,9,11,12 C) 1,13 D) 6,10	<b>9 – TURFWAY PARK (7:00 ET)</b> <b>HOLIDAY CHEER 250K, 6F SYNTHETIC</b> <b>65</b> <b>3 HOWARD WOLOWITZ</b> 5-2 11 JOE SHIESTY 10-1 4 OUT ON BAIL 10-1 13 INCINERATOR 30-1 <b>PICK: 3 HOWARD WOLOWITZ</b> Many significant scratches in here leaves this one as the main player. He has won nearly \$1.8M in his career and is 1 for 1 here at TP (won this race last year). Biggest win was the G1 Franklin Simpson at KD in Sep 2024. Clearly looks like a sprinter so the drop back from a mile in the G1 last time out is preferred. Irad Ortiz is up. Big win shot. <b>VALUE: 11 JOE SHIESTY</b> Upset winner of the 2024 William Walker at CD at nearly 30-1. Two of his last three starts were full of trouble and can be overlooked. He was the 7-5 favorite in last but the trouble cost him any chance. He was off slow from the 2 post in the stakes 3 back and never got comfortable after that. He's 2 for 5 here at TP. Might be sent to the lead here. A) 3 B) 4,6,11,13 C) 12 D) 9,10	<b>10 – TURFWAY PARK (7:30 ET)</b> <b>MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 100K, 1M 1/16 SYNTHETIC</b> <b>42</b> <b>12 STILL SOBER</b> 12-1 5 EMPIRE WEST 5-2 1 FLASH THE MAGIC 15-1 4 THAILAND 3-1 <b>PICK: 12 STILL SOBER</b> He was 5 <sup>th</sup> beaten just two-lengths in the common race at CD last time out. Notice he had the blinkers on for two starts (the prior two) and they were awful. The three with no blinkers are all very decent. Thought he overcame no pace to be running on well at 75-1 in the last start. Is bred for this. Has a strong 5F work since last. Will be closing in. <b>VALUE: 1 FLASH THE MAGIC</b> He's run twice and split the field in both. Has excuses. He was off slow sprinting on the dirt at over 100-1 in the first start. He did pretty well to beat some after the slow start from the gate. Really lost momentum in the first furlong on the rail when steadied hard in last. Don't think we got to see his best.
