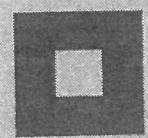

Orb

Rosario let him settle in the Derby and didn't rush and that was one of the keys to victory; proven on fast and off surfaces and able to adapt to the fast Derby pace but was also closer to the lead in the slower pace of the Florida Derby; 5 of the last 11 Kentucky Derby winners won the Preakness; splits of the Monday drill included a first quarter in :12.21, and he got his final quarter in :23.12, his trainer about the move, Shug: "I thought it was freaky. It didn't look like he got out of a high gallop. It gave me chills, That's what good horses do"; Gary Stevens was impressed with runner's Derby as told to Steve Haskin, Stevens: "Orb was still a fresh horse after the race, and the reason I know that is, he wasn't looking to pull up"; repeater.

Goldencents

This guy ran better than appears in last as he got caught up in the fast splits when Palace Malace was loose on the lead, and the whole complexion of the race changed; the first contender to show up here runner tries duplicate what Louis Quatorze did in 1996 when 16th in the Derby but a winner in this race; expect huge effort; trainer O'Neill in the Courier-Journal, O'Neill: "We're still scratching out head on how the Derby unfolded. I think he just didn't enjoy the kickback, the slop and where he was. Kevin (Kriger) did a great job. When Palace Malice flew out of there, there was no sense in chasing him. It just wasn't his day. I think the (Preakness) shorter distance, and we'll just take the approach of 'come and get us'.

Titledown Five

By now most know this runner is part owned by former Green Bay Packers Paul Hornung and Willie Davis and he will be running for the end zone from the sound of the bell with his natural .45 flat speed; wide in his first two starts, he has only run one poor race when out in post 10 in this Grade 2 debut; runner is bred to run till the cows come home as his sire Tiznow won the Breeders Cup Classic twice and his dam won multiple Group races in South American and also won the Grade 2 Rampart at Gulfstream in 2005 at 9 furlongs; with others runners in here with designs on the lead, just not sure the race sets up all that great for this colt.

Departing

New shooter flashed new wrinkle in last settling from post 13 and drawing away getting the last furlong in :12.63; not convinced he was beating anybody in last; the place horse was coming off about a 7-week layoff at 23-1 and his only win vs. winners was in a \$50K optional at Hawthorne with an 88 Beyer; at least one horse that skipped the Derby has finished in the Preakness trifecta 9 of the last 11 years and 8 finished in the exacta; in his only loss he was right there are the top of the lane in the strong Louisiana Derby but could not carry on with the momentum; co-owned by Claiborne Farm, the same farm where Orb was raised and in fact the two horses were raised in the same paddock, could envision him behind a legit pace, and then making the one run.

Mylute

This guy held his own at Churchill; there is not as much speed in this race as the Derby but a few do have designs on the top; in the Derby the horses that were 16th, 15th, 17th, 12th and 18th, finished one through 5; this runner looked like a short horse in the Risen Star and was 3 clear while nearly ringing the bell at 19-1 in the Fair Grounds finale; Napravnik becomes only the third female rider to compete in this race; the May 13 in :49 3/5 work was the 20th best of 40 drills and he galloped out in 1:04 2/5; Amoss has always let his horses tell him where to run and he has been pleased with this colt, Amoss: "It was a good breeze. This was similar to what he did before the Kentucky Derby but just a bit faster"; should move forward.

Oxbow

Three poor posts then the dreaded rail in last when he made the nice middle move in a better than looked race; the three quarter split was the 4th fastest ever; of those that got caught up in the crazy pace last time, this guy finished the best of them and that is admirable; pedigree screams distance on both sides; Stevens, looking for his third Preakness, about the last work, Gary: "Time was not a factor and this was more about his mind and keeping him relaxed. The main thing is to keep him happy. I think I am sitting on the right horse, with the right style".

Will Take Charge

Soph has that good race/off race thing going on; toss the sloppy Southwest; the Derby was better that it looks; he was going stride for stride with the eventual winner but got stopped on a dime when Verrazano tired and started drifting; he was fully extended and now muar move forward; pedigree is classy enough; his trainer was pleased with the 5/13 move, Lukas: "He did exactly what we asked him to do. After a tough mud race, you've got to be careful not to overdo it. Between the Derby and Preakness, I think it's important to get a good feel for their energy levels and conditioning. The times on these works mean very little. It's more about how they've bounced out of the race and what they're telling you they want to do next"; not impossible chore.

Runner figures to throw his hat into the speed brigade ring; game in the maiden breaker, did finish the last furlong in :12.58 in New Mexico; the place horse in last didn't exactly flatter this runner by finishing 11th of 14 in Departing's Illinois Derby; go deep into runner's pedigree and fans will find Silverbulletway, a champion and over \$3 million career; some snappy moves at Churchill including the drill last Monday; Jim Barnes, Bob Baffert assistant, sent this guy 6 furlongs and he galloped out in 1:24 4/5; he worked in company with stablemate Fed Biz, an older horse who is a Grade 2 winner; Barnes: "Bob told me to give him a stiff work. That looked like a stiff work to me. He was under urging to keep up"; needs very best.

Name didn't fit last time as he may have just hated the off going; raw talent is there, but he has to prove he can transfer his good Florida form; the pace was moderate in the Florida Derby but runner still gave it up in the lane; in the drill last Sunday between races at Monmouth Park, this charge was timed in :23.40 the final quarter of a mile and his trainer had him galloping out in :59.60; only 2 and a half off the lead in the slop last time but he really didn't seem to want to go on; could see him sitting in a good spot when the real racing belongs, it will just be a matter if he can out battle some more accomplished runners.

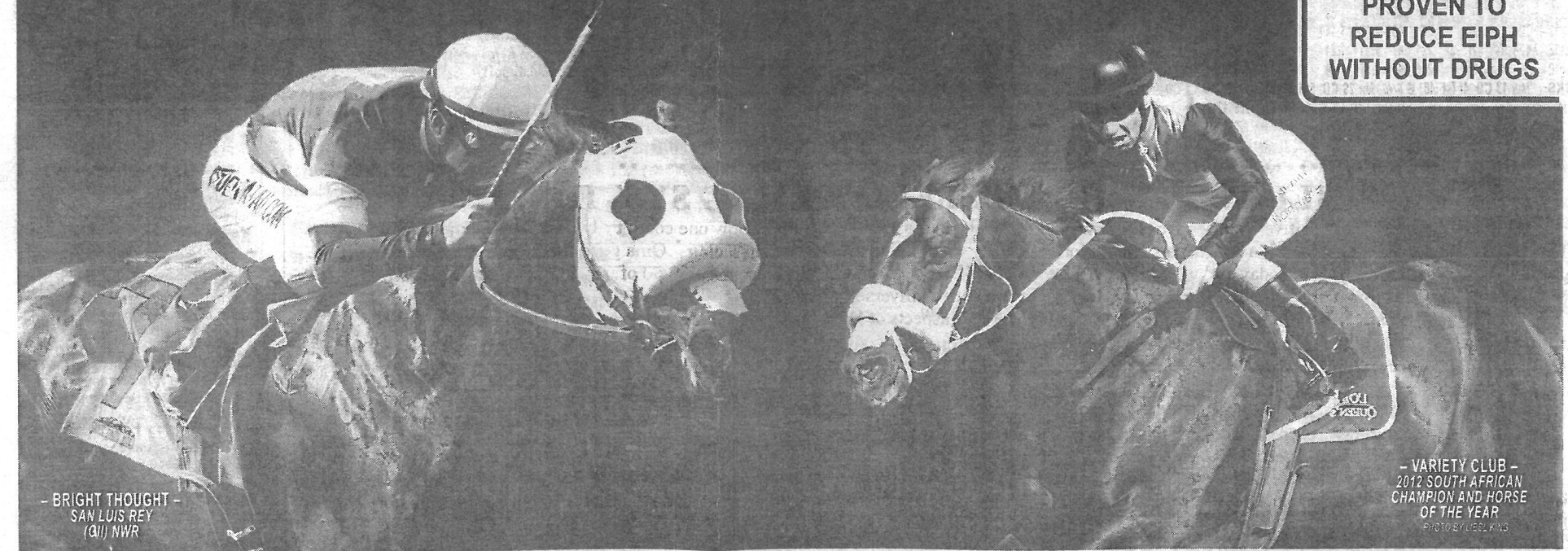
