ALOMA'S RULER broke in stride and was quickly angled to the rail. Taken in hand and relaxed nicely while setting the pace, he turned back BOLD STYLE entering the far turn and accelerated to increase his advantage under light rousing approaching the stretch. ALOMA'S RULER then continued resolutely in response to alternate right and lefthanded whipping to determinedly hold off LINKAGE. LINKAGE, reserved snugly outside, was always within striking distance. He responded willingly when set down entering the stretch and closed steadily in a game effort. CUT AWAY, rated along the rail, eased out between horses at the top of the stretch, split foes near the eighth pole and finished willingly. BOLD STYLE broke sluggishly and slightly in the air, was rushed to prompt the early pace outside ALOMA'S RULER, was sent up to challenge entering the far turn and fell back. LASER LIGHT circled wide to reach contention midway through the far turn and weakened in the drive while bumping repeatedly with REINVESTED. REINVESTED, in hand behind horses to the far turn, swung outside entering the stretch and bumped with LASER LIGHT in the final sixteenth. WATER BANK was not a factor.
