CLOSER LOOK Late-bloomer's Derby dreams were dashed following the Risen Star, but he rebounded in the Lexington motoring away after a 5-wide turn bid; ran fine in the Preakness as he swung 7 wide and was outfinished by two rail-skimmers; off a beat slow in the Ohio Derby, but the trip worked out great despite the pace slowing on the backstretch; bided his time behind the leaders, followed Math Wizard's bid, altered course inside that one in the lane and resolutely got it done; barn is 5 for 12 (42%, \$5.66 ROI) over the past 5 years with last-out 3-year-old winners returning from 2 to 4 month layoffs; doesn't have much speed and will be at the mercy of race and pace luck, but he will come running if the fractions are fair; exotics threat at the very least.

CLOSER LOOK Shug has won the Travers 3 times and this colt created buzz with a debut win here; troubled Champagne as he stumbled terribly at the start and altered 4 wide on the turn; missed the BC with illness and seemed short when wide in his seasonal debut; received a beautiful ride saving ground behind a hot pace to win the FOY, then was stymied by a lack of pace when Maximum Security wired the Florida Derby; another great trip in the Derby as he sat behind Maximum Security and avoided the drama by shooting up the fence; last behind a slow pace in the Dwyer, but Johnny V. avoided swinging 5 wide; stayed in, split horses and was getting away despite the jock dropping the stick; distance a question, but he seems to be coming in on an upward trajectory; factor.

CLOSER LOOK Has come a long way in a short amount of time as he missed his juvenile campaign and didn't get started until April; he and Brown's leading 3yo filly Guarana were working together prior to their debuts and Highest Honors would likely be 3-for-3 if not for finding inside traffic trouble in that sprint; settled comfortably at the back of the pack going into the 1st turn of the Curlin, then advanced four wide in tandem with Endorsed on the far bend; grinded that win out and acts like the extra furlong won't be a problem; it's possible the outside was best here on that sloppy July 26 main track and Highest Honors might have been aided by being wide; a very talented prospect getting a class test; may fit best on bottom of single-race exotics.
