Claimed by top local trainer Mac Robertson two back. He added blinkers in the next start and he was third for 50k at Oaklawn Park. Two in here were well behind him in that race. Sib to the multiple stakes winner (dirt) Coastal Charm. She won 333k in her career. The main knock will be if he can handle the turf. There is no obvious turf breeding in the deep pedigree.

VALUE: 3 JUST KEEP LOOKING
His form is downright rotten. He won the debut in MSW at Delaware Park on the turf at this distance. But since then he beat just 5 horses total in the next 5 starts. He's just not facing anything besides the top choice in here and for that reason he can compete. He did have less than ideal gate breaks in 3 of the last 4 starts. He has been facing much better company.

PICK: 3 THAT TYPE OFA DEAL

The breeding is superior for a Mn-bred. Sire won the BC Sprint and is one of the better sires nationally. Dam is a sib to Letruska who won over \$3M in her career routing on the dirt (5-time G1 winner). Trainer and owner have had a few nice Mn-breds (most notably stakes winner Street Warrior). Did nothing in debut in stakes but comes back with Lasix and a sharp drill.

VALUE: 6 NAVARRE

This is certainly a 3-horse race and this one has every chance to pull off the minor upset. This is 1 of 3 for Troy Bethke and he puts the hot rider of the moment up (Americano). Was a game third right behind the likely morning line favorite, Shances R, the last time he was in MSW (two back). Adds Lasix for the first time. Won't be worse than third in this MSW race.

PICK: 3 SEPTEMBER MAGIC

Mac Robertson has the top two favorites in this race and both look like they could win here. This 5YO mare was claimed two back for 26k. She ran evenly in opt clm 35k last time out but has some races that have her right in the win mix. She was second for straight 32k claiming at Keeneland just 6 back. Adds the talk of the town rider Americano (3 for 5 riding for Mac).

VALUE: 1 MIA BABY

7YO mare has a very good record at Canterbury Park. She is 7 for 8 in the top three here on the dirt. She had two wins last year and both were with Kelsi Harr riding. She pressed the pace in one of them and gamely won at 9-1. In the other she closed from off the pace. Faced a pretty decent str allowance at WRD in last. Second won an op clm at Prairie Meadows next.

Sire is a very good turf influencer. This one has a strong runner-up finish on the turf at ELP last August. He's been facing better foes at Tampa Bay Downs in MSW there. Winner two back crushed a 100k opt clm group next at Aqueduct for Chad Brown. Winner three back won the G2 Wood Memorial next and then ran in the Ky Derby. The one to beat on the circuit change.

VALUE: 6 ATHLETIC LIKE

Trainer Coty Rosin has 4 wins at the meet. All 4 were for this same owner Novogratz Racing Stables. Not much by way of turf breeding. His only try on the turf came in the second start at over 100-1 at Keeneland when he was out of the 10 post in that 12-horse field. Has run with and beaten a bit better than what is here. Must respect the class drop and connections.

This is the female family that produced the G1 placed turfer, Insta Erma, for Bill Mott. She ran 2nd a neck in the 2017 Lady Canterbury on this turf course. Sire's best runner to date is the 868k turf earner Lady Shipman. Winner two back won a 125k opt clm at FG next. Trainer is 5 for 31 for this ownership at CBY. Adds Lasix. Expecting this trainer to win a bunch here.

VALUE: 2 DOKKODO

Considered him for the top spot but these connections rarely win. Trainer is 3% (2 for 71). One of the wins did come with the one horse he trained for this owner. Had a 2nd, 3rd and 4th in the three starts in Kentucky. Those tracks (TP and KEE) produce a lot of winners when they leave for some of the weaker jurisdictions. Dam was all turf. So were two sibs. Might shock.
