He was very game in the win off the layoff two back. Was outsprinted early in last at TAM. Both he and the other speed tired out of the race.

Nice pedigree here. Sib Big World won the G1 La Troiene back in 2017. 4-time stakes winner Tensas Yucatan is deeper in the female line. Moved to turf in the last start and wired the field after setting fast fractions. Pletcher is 22% with a last out md winner into a turf stakes (8 for 36). This is the speed of the speed.

Comes back at 7F for a trainer who is 25% on route to sprint angle (a bit higher when off a long layoff). Perfectly spaced worktab. Jose Ortiz gets up.

Back to his early racing days here. Moves back to dirt. He adds blinkers and Jaramillo. All the things that got him 3 wins in a row to start his career (although the 3rd win was a DQ to 2nd in a stakes). Can make excuses for all 4 starts off the layoff. He worked well on March 24th. Should carve out a nice trip today.

This Chad Brown 5YO mare was a G1 winner as a 3YO with a 5-1 win in the Belmont Oaks. Was 12th in the BC F&M Turf but beaten just a bit over 6-lengths from a wide gate at 23-1. She is 1 for 1 at the distance having won the G2 Glens Falls 4 back at Saratoga. Irad is back as the regular rider. Travels midpack.

Value: 8 Anatolian

She's run well in 6 of her last 7 starts. The last two came here going long distances on the turf without Lasix. She outran her odds in both starts (2nd and 3rd at 9-1 and 28-1). The winner of the last start has won 5 of 6 off an extended layoff. Might have to take a step forward to beat the top 3 favorites in this stakes.

Dam was a 7-time stakes winner (all on dirt sprinting) of over 800k. Deep in the female family is a multiple Grade 1 winning sprinter, Housebuster (won \$1.3M in the 1980's). Gets class and stamina from the sire line. First on a fast dirt track in the last start. She went 22.1 for the second half. Can be any kind.

Value: 5 Into Champagne

Just a half of a length from being a perfect 3 for 3 coming into this one. She made a move to the leaders in the G2 last time out before she tired a bit very late. It was her first start routing so she likely needed the race. 2nd dam, Pool Land, won the G1 Ruffian at BEL back in 2016 (won 500k in just 11 career starts).

She did win off the layoff here in an opt clm last year. She won this race in '23 with a late surge into a slow pace. One to beat, not to bet.

Saffie Joseph/Kenneth Ramsey mare was beaten a head in the 2022 version of this race. Moves back to the grass after twice trying synthetic earlier this year. Has shown tactical speed at longer distances but her best efforts have really been coming off the pace. She has the ideal rider for that style with Rosario.

Connections paid \$1M for him as a yearling. Was off slow first time out on a muddy track. He ran decently there but he really took off when he went long 2 back. 5 runners directly behind him in maiden win all hit the board in MSW next (2 winners). Trainer won this race in '13 with Orb (won the Ky Derby after).
