The slow 3F breeze is big signal that this one is ready to go.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 RUN AWAY FLASH Nibbled last year in MSW company and is one of the few that has a run off the break in 2020. Split the field at WRD at 6-1 odds in last. 7th returned to run 2nd in Tx-bred MSW at LS next at odds of 5-1.
