He ran pretty well in Texas but the wheels fell off in the first start here in OK. Gelded after that poor run last time out. Deep closer has enough backclass facing better Texas-breds to beat these. Trainer hitting at 30% and he does well dropping into high claiming. Blinkers off. Expect him to be finishing fast.

VALUE: 1 LIFE AT SEA

Last time he was at this level was 3 starts ago. He ran well for second behind one who came back to win 3 times including a stakes at Lone Star. He likely needed the start off the long layoff last time out. Connections don't give up on him and only drop him slightly. Regular rider Quinonez stays aboard here.

Showed good speed in the neck defeat two back with this same rider aboard. She was unlucky there as she ran good enough to win. Asmussen hitting at 25% so far at this meet.

VALUE: 7 MERRY MARY LOU

Trainer Francisco Bravo has two in the race and they apparently have been working together as these works are identical. Second dam ran for this owner and trainer and won nearly 200k. Bravo is 4 for 18 (22%) with 8 in the money and a \$3.36 ROI with a debut two-year old in a MSW sprinting with this rider.

He's been facing better company of late. Won the JB Connelly six back with Elliott riding. Finally gets an inside post. Good trip saving ground.

VALUE: 4 OCELOT

Was hammered down to 2-5 in the prep for this race. He ran to the betting in an easy win. That was his third in in six starts. He's won 14 times in his career and is 5 for 9 on this turf course. He's won 11 times on the grass. He can set the pace or come from far back. Rider won two of four with him. Late finish.

Held a full field of Texas-bred stakes runners safe in the 10-1 win last time out. They clearly had this race in mind after the win and have worked her well up to this spot.

She's won 2 of her last 3 starts although those were off the turf races. She is 3 for 4 in the exacta on this turf course. Another one who will be sitting well back of the pace and could be catching wobbly pacesetters in the lane. She has four decent works prepping for this. Should get the right pace setup here.

Diodoro clearly brought the medicine bag to Oklahoma. He's winning at 44% for the meet. He claimed this one two back for 32k and promptly moved him into a tougher race and earned a career high 100 Beyer. Winner has two big wins (100 Beyers) in three starts. He's 6 for 11 at the distance. Will be forward.

VALUE: 8 BLUE LIGHT

Comes into this race having won 7 of 10 starts. Flat in the last start when third in the four horse field. That was likely just a prep for this spot. Rider Diaz has 5 wins in 7 starts aboard him. He could use a fast pace as he'll be sitting well behind early. Figures to move up off the comebacker. He once sold for 350k.

Drew a wide post (10) in the field of 12 in the debut at Ellis Park. The public sent him off at nearly 20-1. But he was much the best in there and was able to spread them out behind him. That race produced 5 runners who ran in the money next out (1 winner). Asmussen is 6 for 12 for this ownership with 2YO's.

VALUE: 2 ROOSTER J

Last time Danny Pish started a second time 2YO that won the debut it was on this stakes day here last year. He won the Kip Deville with this same rider up. There were likely some expectations for this one to run. They paid 165k for him a year ago. Has 4 solid works for this. He really can be any kind of runner.

Brad Cox is 8 for 22 (36%) with 17 in the money (77%) in stakes at RP in the last 4 years. He won this race last year with Alpine Princess. That winner also shipped in from Kentucky. Cox is 18 for 49 (37%) with 35 in the money (71%) in non-graded stakes for Godolphin ownership. Saez was up in the maiden win.

VALUE: 1 SERAPHIA

Gun Runner filly is one of two in the race for Steve Asmussen. Was second to the top choice in the Ellis Park allowance in last. The rider lost the crop in the lane and she couldn't stay with the Cox winner. Clockers liked her last work at Ellis which was second fastest at the distance. We haven't seen her best yet.

He was beaten less than a length on the cutback last time out in an opt clm at Del Mar. The winner came back to run second in the G2 Eddie D at Santa Anita on Saturday at 6-1. Eurton won the RP Oaks in 2021 in his only start on this track. Won a 100k stakes at this distance without Lasix in the start 5 back.

VALUE: 3 DARK AFTERNOON

Moved to Alex Hartman before the start two back and he won both starts for him. They were both at this distance on the grass and this one is now 5 for 11 on the turf at 5F. Oklahoma-bred is 5 for 8 on the Remington Park turf course so far in his career. Rider Diego has 2 wins and a runner-up finish aboard him.

But the third place finisher, Magnitude, came back to run huge when second in the G1 Pennsylvania Derby last weekend. 5th from the Haskell was Burnham Square, nosed out next in the \$3.5M Nashville at 13-1. In good form.

Can really never count out one that likes to win. Diodoro, a Canadian, took him to Canada for some of the bigger races there. He swept them at very low odds. He's 7 for 8 on a fast dirt track (although once DQ'd to 7th). He will get test for class in here. Diodoro winning with just about everything at this meet.
