She made a late run in both of her last two starts & they were the first two for this trainer. Rider change to Eikleberry and gets another crack at the shorter distance on the turf. Seems to be enough pace here to keep it honest. Will be the one closing fastest late.

VALUE: 1 EMERALD PRINCESS

Pretty big class drop here for trainer Mac Robertson and rider Vega. She went fast early in allw last time out and tired. Blinkers come off but with the rail it's likely she'll go to the lead here. Class relief will help her chances. 2nd three back would be enough to win.

Well-bred Mn-bred always hinted at ability since he won his debut at Churchill Downs in MSW compnay in 2019. Rattled off 3 wins on the turf here in 2020. Continued that form on the turf this year. It took a track record to beat him 4 back. Speed of the race.

VALUE: 5 JP WARRIOR

Don't see many 13-length winners on the turf here but that is what he did three back. He followed that up with a win vs. open allowance two back. Drew a wide 9 post in last vs a good field that included the next out Wally's Choice stakes winner Zoe's Delight.

Mn-bred has been in with tough company. That was a key race two back. 1st, 3rd, 5th and 9th from that one all won next out. 7th was second at 9-1 on a drop last week. Stakes placed in Mn-bred company. He's now at the lowest level of his career. He'll be tough today.

VALUE: 7 YESTERYEAR

Nice win vs a bit cheaper last out. This Mn-bred beat a softer Mn-bred claiming group but looked good in doing it. That was his second win in his last 4 starts with the other two being runner-up finishes. Should be sent from the outside post to assume command.

Trainer Karl Broberg wins a lot first off the claim. He's starting this one for the Next Level Canterbury Group so there is sure to be money on her. Broberg is 22 for 74 (30%) first off the claim and running back at CBY. Overcame traffic to win with Eikleberry in last.

VALUE: 6 ACCORDING TO ASPEN

In the exacta in 7 of 14 starts on the turf. She had a big year in 2020 with 2 wins and 3 placings from just 6 starts. Made a belated start to the meet in last at a distance that is too short for her (5F). Gets added ground here so expect her to move forward in here.

He has a win at the meet when he beat 4k claimers in the start 4 back at 9-1. Has been at higher claim price since then and now drops back today. Didn't run too bad vs better (runner-up at 10k two starts ago). Will be a decent price from off the pace today.

VALUE: 6 PAROLEE

Comes out of the same race as the top choice last time out. Showed more speed in there and tired in a pace that was too fast. He's been in the money in 10 of 18 on fast dirt. Another one that should be off the pace today. Negron rode him for 2 wins earlier.

He's been facing high level company in the last few starts. He won 3 back by daylight at this level and it was with Eikleberry up. Off a bit slow in last but he was really picking up steam late. 4 of his 5 wins are at this track on the dirt. He drops to the correct level.

VALUE: 6 BANKROLL BEN

Trainer has 3 wins at this meet and 2 of them were of the boxcar odds variety (31-1 and 38-1). This one was his 31-1 winner two back. He's 0 for 12 with zip in the money on the turf so it wasn't surprisingly in that he ran poorly on that surface last out. Sneaky.

PICK: 2 SILVER DASH

Was favored on the class drop last time out going 1 mile on the dirt. He was steadied in there but kept going and finished a decent third. Had problems 2 back at 16-1 in the allowance. Rider change to the 2020 leading rider Eikleberry. Class drop is the key.

VALUE: 1 MACHO RAPIDO

Just dominated what looked like a good MSW group two back at 5-1. Was not really bet last out in same race the top choice was favored and finished 4th in there, 7 behind Silver Dash for third. Might be a bit better than that showing. Gets the inside post here.

PICK: 2 BRAHMS IS WHO

Can excuse the last place finish three back as she was in MSW company there. Dropped to this level 2 back and was third just 2 behind Danzig Star there at 16-1. Faced MSW company again going 5F on turf here. Will be picking them off coming down the lane.

VALUE: 3 CRAZY GOOD

Banking on the trainer change to bump this one up in here. She was claimed 3 back for 10k. That was a poor effort as the 2-1 second choice. Bumped start last out and never really got into the race when 4th at 7-1. Leading rider up. Should be closing in today.
