PICK: 1 THE OLD NINE

A lot will depend on the trip for this one. He draws inside but is a deep closer in here. He should be able to save a lot of ground and roll outside for a wide move into the lane. He did just that two back and almost won at this level. The blinkers come off and Kimura is up for the first time. He'll get some pace to work with. Class drop helps his chances.

VALUE: 6 BELLY UP

Seems pretty honest for this 25k level. He won for 25k nw2 5 back here wire to wire. Was over his head a bit in the allw next time out but still ran a credible third. Comes in off of a troubled trip. Tends to break running but doesn't seem to need the lead to win. He has 5 works prepping for this return and is teamed up with Ayuso who rode him 2 times.

PICK: 3 ONE STEP BEYOND

The most experienced runner in the field with 8 starts. He has been in the money in 6 of those 8 starts including last out when beaten a neck at this level. He's faced Cal-breds 4 times. He has 3 in the money from those starts and one where he was 4th when checked badly (3rd career start). He isn't facing much today. He'll be forwardly placed in here.

VALUE: 6 MR. TARIFF

Hasn't shown any speed in either start but did close in for third last out despite some traffic. Faced open class first time out. It's never easy to win going long in the debut at this level. He did improve from the first start to the second start. Adds Lasix for the first time today. Likely tucks down to the inside early and make a move on the far turn today.

PICK: 3 PROUDLY HAILED

Turfway Park, where this one raced the last two times out, might be the toughest track in the country right now. This one was 4th out of 11 in each of the two starts there. Winner of the start two back won an opt clm next as did the place finisher and 5th place runner. 5th in the last start went to FG and won an allowance next (90 Beyer). Crafty rider gets up.

VALUE: 1 SILLY RABBIT

Shipped in from Delaware Park for the last start. He beat 5 runners home at 13-1 in a decent effort routing. That start came back in August. Cuts back in distance for first time in his career. Trainer Ryan Hanson has had a decent meet so far (6 in the money, 2 wins). Gets one of the better jockeys for this (Berrios). Has been especially good in turf sprints.

PICK: 1 AUDITORY Very consistent for this level. She was last in an allowance at Los Alamitos and was the even money favorite. She ran third after a slow start and wide trip. It was a better than it may look effort after that trip. Beat some of these in the starter two back that was very similar to this race. She has 5 wins in her last 11 starts. Her finishing numbers are good.		PICK: 6 INBOX She had just one start and it was in an allowance in Ireland when off at 50-1. She was facing males in there, and the winner had nibbled in Group 2 races prior. D'Amato 15 for 62 (24%) with a Euro shipper into a MSW on the turf in the US. Clockers indicate she has worked well for this. She has Lasix for the first time here. Really can be any kind of filly.		PICK: 4 WISHTHEYALLCOULD BE Claimed for 20k in the last start. That is looking like it may be a good claim given how show crushed a Cal-bred opt claiming group at 7-2 odds and did so from the widest 13 post. Has tactical speed but does her best running from a bit behind the pace. Caught a pretty good race two back as the winner came back to win 25k claimer for fun on turf.	
VALUE: 6 OUTRAGEOUS She beat the top choice in the start 6 back at 8-1. She has just one poor start since then and it was two back. It looks as something went wrong there as she was laid off. Came back with one of her best efforts when she dominated at LRC over a field of 12. She went up and pressed the pace in there from a wide post. Certainly fits and at a good price.		VALUE: 3 CHANNEL PLACE One of two in the race for Doug O'Neill. She went out too quickly in the last start and tired in the lane. That was her first start routing and she was on the rail so it might have been circumstantial that they went so hard early in there. Adds Lasix and Berrios. She has 4 works since last start for a solid team. Expecting her to offer much more in this one.		VALUE: 2 BUDS N SUDS She might be the only true closer in the race. She comes from far back and should get some pace to run into with a small field. She might be a tad over her head but might be able to overcome that if the right pace scenario unfolds in front of her. She did make up good ground to get third at 25-1 three back in a similar spot. Probably best underneath.

PICK: 10 RESOLVE One of two in the race that comes out of the G1 American Oaks. She was 36-1 in there and closed in a bit late to run 5 th beaten just two lengths. Last two starts came on a good turf. She'll get a firm turf today. Hasn't won on this turf so far but is 4 for 7 in the money. Big rider change here to the very good Berrios. Figures to come with a strong late run.		PICK: 4 BRILLIANTLY Bob Baffert has 3 of the 6 runners in the race. This one will give him the best chance to win. Went wire to wire on turf three back to break her maiden. Blinkers came off for the two starts after. Baffert was obviously not happy with that and the come back on today. JJ Hernandez rode her first two times out including the win. Seems well spotted here.		PICK: 9 SHEZMISBEHAVING She is a bit pace dependent at this distance. She was dead last in her most recent start and didn't start to move until it was too late. She did split the field at 21-1 beaten just 3 lengths in the end. This is her second try sprinting on turf and should be better having the run last out. Pereira rode her to her last win (2024) which came here at 68-1 at a mile.	
VALUE: 7 TAKE A BREATH Finished a head in front of the top choice in the same G1 American Oaks. That was with Irad Ortiz up. Rider that is up today is in from Gulfstream Park where he had a lot of success there. Lost to the top choice here at SA in the one three back but had a lot of traffic issues in that race. Mark Glatt having a typically strong meet. Comes running late.		VALUE: 6 JANE AUSTEN She is better than she ran in the G3 last time out. She was in a pulling action for much of the start of the race and it seems she tired from fighting the rider late. Figures to pull back and allow some of the other Baffert runners go to the front and make a move late in the race. She was placed in the G2 Summer Oaks at this distance back in 2024. Player.		VALUE: 7 MENDELSSOHNS ANGEL Did little on the stretch out in the last start but she had a troubled trip. She took money (off at under 5-1) and looks like she is better than that showed. Bred on both sides to handle the added distance. Really like her works since the last start (which came in Nov). Notice the 46.3 move on the synthetic just 8 days ago. Should be a very fair price today.

PICK: 8 STERLING SILVER

Hard not to like this NY-bred. She sold for 13k in 2020 and is now a \$1.3M earner. She is 21 of 27 in the money on fast dirt for just short of a million dollars. Castellano is 7 for 16 aboard her. She comes in off a nice prep win and carries just 120 pounds, the lowest since 2024 for her. Can press the pace or come from behind. Very honest, talented mare.

VALUE: 10 ONE MAGIC FILLY

Comes out of the same stakes that was won by the choice here the day after Christmas. That wasn't her best effort. She was the 7-5 favorite but tired in the lane. The Grade 3 runner-up two back could win this race. The winner is just a neck from being 4 for 4 (3 wins by daylight). Third from that race was beaten a neck in the Grade 1 Test last August.

PICK: 2 PROGRAM TRADING

Draw a line through the BC Mile. He was on the inside for the entire race and was blocked and steadied for most of the stretch. Makes just his 4th start in a year and a half but has run well off the bench. He's a two-time Grade 1 winner on the grass. Chad Brown is 5 for 14 (36%) off a layoff like this into a graded stakes on the turf beyond 1M here at GP.

VALUE: 12 FORT WASHINGTON

Second year in a row that this one has drawn the 12 post in this race. He closed well last year to finish 5th beaten just over two lengths at 40-1. Won 3 of 5 starts since then and that includes the G1 Arlington Million at CNL two back. He didn't care for the softer turf at Kentucky Downs last time out. He'll get plenty of pace to close into. Very consistent.

Most of this field is forwardly placed. It will come down to who is able to relax and save something for late. This one came from off the pace to win the G2 CT Classic 4 back at 5-2 odds. Trainer David Jacobson has not decided if he is a sprinter or router. Lost to a legit sprinter in the stakes at OP last out. Toss the G1 BC Sprint as he had much trouble.

VALUE: 7 TAPPAN STREET

Million dollar purchase in 2023 looked like a bargain when he beat superstar Sovereign in the Florida Derby. He hit the bench afterwards before finally returning in an op clm here as a prep for this. Could absolutely get the run of the race behind a very fast pace. Reunites with Luis Saez who was aboard in the first three starts. Should improve off last.
