s-supplementary nomination. Winner B c Sovereign Dancer-Sun Gate (by) Bull Lea. Trained by Jack C. Vanberg. Owned by Kenneth Opstein. Bred by W. R. Davis (Fla). Gate Dancer worked his way to the rail approaching the first turn, continued along the inside while rallying nearing the end of the backstretch, came out to go after Fight Over approaching the stretch, was strongly handled while trying to lug in after gaining a clear lead just inside the final furlong and held sway. Play On reserved behind the leaders into the backstretch was sent up between horses nearing the end of the backstretch, moved to the inside approaching the stretch and finished strongly to best the others. Fight Over came out slightly into Taylor's Special after sprinting to the front approaching the first turn, remained slightly out from the rail while making the pace to the stretch and bore out while tiring. Taylor's Special eased back between horses nearing the first turn, was steadied along while saving ground into the backstretch, came out bothering Swale while making a run nearing the far turn but weakened during the drive. Pine Circle, outrun to the stretch, passed tired horses while racing wide. Wind Flyer failed to be a serious factor. Swale prompted the pace into the backstretch while racing outside fight over, was bothered when Taylor's Special came out nearing the end of the backstretch and was finished before reaching the stretch. Raja's Shark remained well out in the track while racing forwardly to the end of the backstretch and gave way. Pac Soldier away alertly despite bobbling slightly, was outrun thereafter. S.S. Hot Sauce was always outrun.
