Trainer 7 for 18 (39%) in 2nd time 2YO's sprint on dirt when in top 3 in debut.

VALUE: 6 FOOLIN

This is an expensive first time starter for Pletcher. He is by sprint leaning Practical Joke and out of an Unbridled's Song mare. That pedigree points to one who should be precocious. Pletcher is 23% with 2YO firsters sprinting on the dirt in MSW (19% at SAR). But he hasn't won with one in a year here. Tab tote.

He drew the 11 post in the last start and he was sent to the front but went way too fast (46.2 and 1:10.4) and rightly tired in the lane. Connections were not exactly thrilled with that ride and they move over to a top rider Prat for this. He's worked 3 times for this at Fair Hills Training Center. The one to run down.

It was on a wet track when moved from the turf so it can be overlooked. Huge rider move to Irad Ortiz. He was riding in the lone win vs. MSW at KEE back in Oct. Loves the turf.

With the scratches in this race, it really looks like a tall order to beat the favorite Built. But this one has the resume to give him a run. He's 9 for 21 so far in his career and has won over \$1M. He's 7 for 17 on a fast dirt track. Comes into this off a career best fig for Bill Mott. Has a win here. 6 for 11 at the distance.

Slow pace in the last start likely helped her but she could be in a great spot stalking today. Nice works since last out.
