She was a bit slow at the start and sluggish early dropping well off the pace. She finished heads and shoulders above that group of maidens. Dam won a G3 and she produced a lot of stakes winners. Casse started 3 second timers here at TAM that won in debut. All 3 won with Gallardo up.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 FACTORBELLA She needs to improve her figures to compete but she might be able to do that. Won at 16-1 in her first start on turf and overcame traffic to do so. Ran ok in the comeback on this turf in a race she might've needed. She's worked twice and should improve in the second start off the layoff. Winner two back was just second in the G2 Inside Information at GP. Blinkers came off for the first time in last and she ran well when 2nd as an 8-5 favorite. Third start off the layoff. Big run today.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 LADY RADLER Surprisingly flat in the Raven Run at under 10-1 last time out. She went to the shelf and gets a good spot to return. Ran up the track off the shelf last year at GP but don't count that race. She had a miserable trip. She steadied 3 back at PID in the 80k stakes at that track. Love the slow works. It's a big tipoff.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 LITTLE VIC This horse is talented but also a bleeder. He was in a good spot 4 back but backed up in that G1. He bled in that race and laid off. Last 3 weren't good so he was laid off again. Beat the top choice in the Grade 3 Tom Fool on a muddy track. Reportedly on edge in the Jan 14th work. He won multiple G1's overseas including the Prince of Wales and Dubai Sheema Classic. Bill Mott is just 9% with turf routers in debut but moves up to 16% with a 2nd timer routing on turf when off at 10-1 or less. Adds Lasix for this. Expecting serious improvement.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 BELLE OF RIGHTS Shug McGaughey is having quite a meet here. He's won 7 of 14 starts (50%) and been in the money with 12 of the 14 he's sent out here. Decent worktab for the debut. McGaughey has had two firsters on turf at TAM in the last 4 years. Both won at 7-2 odds. Sire gets a lot of very long distance types. The :44.3 half in the Iroquois was the fastest 4F half time of that day (including a 300k sprint won by G1 type Bango). Really love the works leading into this.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 COPPER TAX This is a case of letting the horse take you to where he belongs. Started out in maiden claiming and in restricted allowance at Delaware. He won 5 straight last year before a 6th in the Remsen. If you break down each turf race, there are excuses in them. Taken up badly in the first turf start. Was up on a fast pace and steadied 7 back. Connections tried a G3 despite no on-the-board turf runs going into it. Back on Lasix. Big rider change. Fits in here.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 APROPOS Hard to know what this 4YO will do in her first grass start. She showed some promise early on but beat just 9 runners in the 3 starts since her maiden win.
