






Footnotes

BIRD TOWN stumbled in her initial stride, settled and was taken in hand after the first few jumps, raced three or four wide, commenced her rally leaving the three furlong marker, split foes approaching the final quarter, maneuvered out five or six wide when straightened into the stretch, brushed for a stride with SANTA CATARINA approaching the final sixteenth and drove clear soon after under strong left-handed encouragement. SANTA CATARINA, well in hand while following the leaders five wide around the first turn and into the backstretch, edged closer approaching the far turn, made a bold run through the upper stretch to gain a slight, brief lead at the furlong grounds, brushed for a stride with LADY TAK, came out for a stride brushing with the winner, then couldn't match strides with BIRD TOWN late while gamely saving second. YELL, appeared to be bumped approaching the first turn by LADY TAK and forced in slightly on GO FOR GLAMOUR, was sharply checked for a stride soon after, settled within easy striking distance three or four wide, advanced between foes around the far turn, came out from behind rivals five wide in the final furlong and finished with good courage. ELLLOLUV gained a narrow advantage near the

inside early, went along under careful handling while dueling with TEMPUS FUGIT, shook off that one, continued to battle on even terms for the lead while inside LADY TAK and SANTA CATARINA into the upper stretch, then gradually weakened the last eighth. MY BOSTON GAL, rated forwardly in behind the leaders from the outset, inched closer approaching the final quarter, worked her way out five wide in deep stretch but was empty. LADY TAK leaned in approaching the first turn and appeared to force YELL in a bit, was never far back while between foes three wide under light rating, made a bold run to reach the front briefly at the three-sixteenths pole, exchanged brushes first with ELLOLUV soon after, again with SANTA CATARINA and weakened thereafter. ISLAND FASHION worked her way in five wide early to stalk the leaders, remained prominent to the stretch and flattened out. HOLIDAY LADY, steadied behind rivals approaching the first turn while near the inside, saved ground into the stretch, moved out four wide but failed to rally. ATLANTIC OCEAN, four or five wide, failed to menace. IN CASE OF WIND never reached contention. TEMPUS FUGIT moved up early to press front-running ELLOLUV three wide, held on well until the end of the backstretch and faded. GO FOR GLAMOUR, steadied along the inside approaching the first turn, never was prominent.
