**PICK: 6 CANDY PRINCE**

Trainer Tony Rengstorf has two in the race and this one, a Mn-bred, is in for the higher Mn-bred tag of 25k. Won a key allw here in 2021 (3 back) at 6-1 odds. Has speed to get into the race. Sports two sharp 5F drills on this track in prep for this. Wide post helps.

**VALUE: 4 FIRE EXTINGUISHER**

Won a Mn-bred allw here four back but has beaten just 3 runners (one per race) in the starts since. Figures to lay off what looks a fast pace and could get a perfect trip. If he can revert to the form he had earlier on in his career, he can win. Big question though.

**PICK: 1 SILVER DASH**

Almost pulled off a 5-1 upset at Hawthorne last time out. The winner came back to win a 25k claimer at Hawthorne and then 3<sup>rd</sup> in a starter allw there. First start for one of the top trainers, Joel Berndt. He is 20% taking in new runners off a layoff of this type at CBY.

**VALUE: 6 J J'S WILDCAT**

He's been in the money in 8 of 9 sprinting on a fast dirt track (all came at CBY). He is protected from a claim due to the rules off a layoff at the same or lower condition. So this is more like an allowance race. Strong rider was up for the 7-1 maiden win 3 back.

**PICK: 3 TIGER HUNTER**

This is mostly a turf pedigree but the dam did win the 2010 Minnesota Oaks over this dirt course. Key race exiting at Hawthorne. 2<sup>nd</sup> won a mdn clm by 11 at LRL. 3<sup>rd</sup> won in MSW at HAW next. 5<sup>th</sup> took a mdn clm at FAN by 9. Been working steadily for this return.

**VALUE: 2 LANAKILA**

There is some win early/sprint pedigree in this one. Two sibs each earned over 130k sprinting (stakes placed Ray's Angel). This trainer started 3 debut runners for North Star Stables. All 3 were full sibs to this one. They ran 2<sup>nd</sup> (neck), 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. Bullet work.

**PICK: 8 BON DEUX**

Oaklawn Park shipper has just two starts so far there. The debut was pretty good. It was in a mdn clm 10k and he closed to within 4 in the end despite a slow start. Drew the rail next and was sent vs. 20k company and he tired. Gets 2021 top rider (Wade) up for this.

**VALUE: 2 HIGHTAIL COWBOY**

Arkansas-bred ships in from OP. He's been facing statebred company there. Has been on the board in 4 of 6 starts. Didn't get any help from the post draw in last and was bit wide in there. 6<sup>th</sup> beaten 13 out of last won an Ark-bred mdn 20k next at 7-1 going long.

**PICK: 4 RUSH HOUR TRAFFIC**

The sibs all seemed to love the off-track in their racing career led by a multiple stakes Dame Plata. This one broke her maiden on a sloppy track easily here in 2019. She ran well in 2 of 3 starts since leaving CBY. She's working really well. She'll be sent out early.

**VALUE: 8 BEACH FLOWER**

She might benefit the most for this race off the turf. She's run well on the dirt (377k of her 537 career earnings. 9YO was excellent three back at OP but tailed off in the last 2 starts. Robertson started the meet 7 for 14 (50%). Should try to come from off the pace.

**PICK: 1 TIGER DAD**

This one moves up on the move to the dirt even though he had run well on grass. The others in here aren't as proven on dirt as he is. Won a 60k at TUP at 1M first off claim for Diodoro and upset winner last start in a 100k. No Lasix, missed start last time out.

**VALUE: 8 TUT'S REVENGE**

Ran 2<sup>nd</sup> in this race last year when it came off the turf and won the 50k Golden Circle at Prairie Meadows on a muddy track back in 2019. Has tactical speed but he doesn't need the lead to win. Harry Hernandez up (3<sup>rd</sup> winningest rider in the US). Good form.

**PICK: 7 MINISTER OF SOUL**

This 8YO gelding is not a turf horse so the move to the main track is ideal for him. He won an opt clm at TUP last out as a pretty big favorite in a small field. He won twice on this dirt track last summer/fall. Gets a top rider for this. Looks strong in this spot.

**VALUE: 3 SIR WELLINGTON**

One of two in the race for the top trainer at this track, Mac Robertson. This one was a 150k stakes winner at OP last year. Hasn't been as sharp off the long break. He's 2 for 4 on an off-track and should get some pace to run into here. Top call rider is up for Mac.

**PICK: 1 TAILORBESWIFT**

Ships in from Oaklawn Park for one of the top trainers Tony Rengstorf. This Ark-bred ran well enough two back when 3<sup>rd</sup> vs 10k statebred company. Was 6-1 in last vs open class but was off slow from the rail before going 5-wide. She is 2 for 3 at the distance.

**VALUE: 2 SAILINTHESUNSET**

Trainer had 8 horses make 26 starts here in '21. He won 3 times at odds of 38-1, 31-1 and 6-5. The winners were all coming from Sam Houston and had form reversal. Good run three back when 2<sup>nd</sup> vs. similar. Should show speed. Will be a big price in this race.

**PICK: 1 TONKA WARRIOR**

Ran 3<sup>rd</sup> to two Steve Asmussen runners in the debut at OP. The runner-up out of that race won a MSW at OP next. That track has normally played to inside speed. So it was against the bias when this 160k purchase went 5-wide and closed late. Will be tough.

**VALUE: 3 RUNAWAY HARRY**

He's 3 for 3 in the money on the dirt. Lone race off the board was routing on the turf here in 2021 when he was 4<sup>th</sup>. Has a sprint leaning pedigree. Sire's best runners were sprinters. Female line includes the 10 time dirt sprint, stakes winner Three Diamonds.
