Footnotes

RAGS TO RICHES nicely worked her way in to race between foes three or four wide, continued under patient handling between foes three wide around the far turn, eased out four wide for the stretch run, wrested command in the upper stretch, kicked clear and increased her advantage under energetic hand encouragement. OCTAVE gained a forward position along the rail entering the first turn, briefly awaited room at the five-sixteenths pole, split rivals two or three wide in the upper stretch to loom a solid threat inside RAGS TO RICHES but couldn't threaten her in the late going while superior to the rest. HIGH HEELS, unhurried for a half and saving ground, briefly lacked room approaching the lane, moved three wide when advancing, was bumped for a stride at

the three-sixteenths pole by SEALY HILL when that one leaned in, angled a bit wider soon after when clear and bested the others while not a threat to the top two. DAWN AFTER DAWN, unhurried early and near the inside, had to await room behind foes concluding the second turn near the inside, commenced a menacing run approaching the final furlong, eased out five wide, then altered course back to the inside in the late going while unable to produce the needed response. MISTICAL PLAN worked her way in four wide early to force the pace outside front-running DREAMING OF ANNA, reached the front for a stride or two between calls in the upper stretch, held on well until mid-stretch and tired. DREAMING OF ANNA moved to the fore early, raced in the two path under light restraint, showed the way into the final quarter and faltered. TOUGH TIZ'S SIS, bumped at the start and in a bit tight, followed the leaders six wide, raced in contention to the lane and came up empty. AUTOBAHN GIRL leaned in at the start bumping TOUGH TIZ'S SIS, settled between foes three of four wide, was asked three furlongs out but offered no response. COTTON BLOSSOM, forwardly placed and near the inside, was forced to take up sharply behind DREAMING OF ANNA leaving the three-sixteenths pole and was finished. SWIFT TEMPER failed to reach contention and was seven wide in the lane. CASH INCLUDED saved ground to no avail. SEALY HILL gained a forward position four wide early to stalk the pace, raced forwardly to the lane, leaned in bumping HIGH HEELS at the three-sixteenths pole and tired thereafter. HIGH AGAIN broke a bit awkwardly, raced in contention to the end of the backstretch five or six wide and weakened steadily. GRACE HAPPENS bore out entering the first turn, continued off the inside, began losing contact with the field entering the far turn and was pulled up.
