Good spot.			PICK: 9 LIAM'S LASS VALUE: 10 SHIP IT A) 4,5,9,10 B) 6,8 C) 1,2			PICK: 6 EVAN SING He's 3 for 5 at the distance on the turf. He is actually 3 for 4 at the distance with Lasix. He didn't have it last out in the stakes. Prat was up once (two back) and he won a 100k stake at FG with a 95 Beyer. Only his 3 rd start in the last year and first off the layoff. Working ok.
VALUE: 3 DREAMWITHINADREAM Owns the second best Beyer in the field. He got that 4 starts ago when second at 27-1 in a 50k mdn clm at CD. Toss the sloppy track run at SAR 3 back. Decent 4 th beaten just 3 in the next start vs. a bit better at SAR. Third from last ran 3 rd in mdn clm 50k here on Thu. A) 1,9 B) 2,3,6,7 C) 4,5,6,8,10			VALUE: 2 RIPERTON She looked very good winning in the debut at ELP beating 11 foes at 7-2 odds. Nothing wrong with the runner-up in the Deb at ELP from the rail. Had the rail in the G3 that she and the rail runner come out of. Deserves a look going the longer distance. Good price. Many horses do not take that track. Beat the top pick two back on this turf at 6-1 with a late move in the lane. Comes in with a fast work and a slow breeze just 4 days out. Sign of readiness. She's won 15 of her 24 career starts, 10 for 15 at the distance on the grass and 3 for 3 here at KEE. Beat boys on numerous occasions. She likely did not care for the soft turf at SAR. Won this in 2022 before the G1 BC Turf Sprint win. One to beat.			PICK: 4 TALKIN' CASH Brad Cox is 14 for 32 (44%) with 22 in the top three (69%) with a healthy \$3.19 ROI with a second time who won in debut and running in an allw or opt clm sprinting on dirt. Third from last won a MSW at KEE next and stakes placed after. Dam a sib to 6 stakes winners.			PICK: 6 GOOD AMERICAN Sharp allowance win last out at KD when she went off favored. The 2 nd place finisher from that race won an allowance at CD next. 5 th went to BTP and won an opt clm (80 Beyer). Key race two back as the top two finishers won right back in allw. Price should be right.
VALUE: 9 HAPPY TALK Lukas used to be automatic (like Baffert) w/ a debut 2YO but hasn't been in some years. But he can still win (11% this year). This one is interesting as she has a great worktab at CD. Worked heads up 10/1 w/ stakes placed Seize the Grey. Sibling to G2 winner Laoban. A) 3,8,9 B) 2,6,7 C) 1,4,5,10,11,12			VALUE: 4 TWILIGHT GLEAMING She went off at even money last out at DMR but had an awful trip and never really had a chance. Was only beaten just over 2-lengths to the top choice in this race last year. Has great early speed and trainer is one of the best with turf sprinters. Can make amends. A) 1 B) 2,4,5,7 C) 3,6,8,9			VALUE: 5 BILLY JACK Torres got aboard 3 back and it produced a win at ELP in a fast time. The runner-up from that race won back in MSW at ELP and 4 th out of that race won a MSW at KD next. Excuse the last start on a muddy track. Asmussen one of the best dirt sprint trainers in the US. A) 4 B) 1,3,5 C) 2,6,7,8			VALUE: 10 BRAVO KITTEN Turned into a long distance runner and she has run well on this turf (3 for 3 in the money so far). She hit the board in all 3 starts right off the bench. Winner of last won next start in a 250k stakes at CD. Perfect worktab for the comeback. Gets Geroux for the first time. A) 1,6,7,10 B) 4,11,12,13 C) 5,8,9
