Hedevar The Gold, rated on an open early lead, gamely resisted when challenged by the winner, remained on equal terms until within the final sixteenth but was unable to match strides in deep stretch. Prospectors Gamble lagged well back early, commenced his bid along the inside on the far turn, then finished well in a belated bid to be gaining ground late. Foolish Intent, forwardly placed outside Tejano early, went willingly but lacked the needed closing response. Parlay Me, steaded and brushed with Blair's Cove while racing in tight quarters entering the clubhouse turn, remained reserved while racing in traffic on the backstretch, was fanned well out in the track on the stretch turn, then lacked the needed rally. Classic Account, four wide into the clubhouse turn, was also fanned four wide on the stretch turn. Blair's Cove was brushed by Parlay Me entering the clubhouse turn. Winnerwald was fanned widest of all into the stretch. Tejano, forwardly placed along the inside early, did not respond when asked to pick up the pace nearing the turn, then faltered in the final guarter.
