A CLOSER LOOK

Juvenile Fillies

Sharp Cat

One of the favorites and lucky in the post position draw; historically chalk has done well in this race with 5 favorites winning, 4 2nd-and-3rd choices victorious; filly is sure bred to be a goodie as a half to \$807k earner Star Recruit and she's proven her ability at Del Mar and Belmont; in top company, most impressive effort? the Matron was good, the Frizette very nice (by way of comparison pacewise Serena's Song went :23 3/5, :46 4/5, 1:10 2/5 that day in the Beldame); we were most impressed by the Del Mar Debutante - she won after being close up through absolutely grueling fractions; it's to her credit that she's run as well since; hefty Beyers in comparison with the opposition and seemingly one of the ones to beat; and expect her to race from off the pace.

Minister's Melody

How good was that effort in the Kentucky Cup Juvenile Fillies? closed ground on a day when the surface was very fast (Appealing Skier set a new track record in the Ky Cup Sprint 2 races later), even speed biased; overcame a poor post, mud in her face to get the place; how legit was that affair, though? pacesetter Corporate Vision came back to show speed and a healthy recede by 17 lengths in the Alcibiades; obviously runner's main appeal lies in her versatile style, and there's certainly no shortage of speed in here to set up her kick; but is she good enough to be in the exacta? have serious reservations.

Runaway Mary

Filly has some ability yet no pedigree power as the lone sibling was exported to Panama; this gal has hobnobbed with some decent types, nibbled in the stakes game; appears overmatched from a Beyer standpoint, though, and worth noting that in the 1990s EVERY 1-2 finisher had a pre-BCJF Beyer of at least 85; thus, this one's main appeal comes via her closing style.

Storm Song

Any key races in her past? sure has plenty of Graded events on her card, and the Matron-Frizette route has been a potent way to play with '95 winner My Flag and '94 winner Flanders taking this path to BCJF success; on her game, has the race-high Beyer of '95 via the Frizette and that the aver-

Cheyenne City

Seems the weakest link of the Lukas-trained trio (City Band and Sharp Cat with graded success); sure bred to be a nice one, though, as a full to SW, \$400k earner Boone's Mill, who earned \$184k at age 2 while winning the '94 Sapling; but only 2 have stretched out to winning efforts in the BCJF and this gal is untested past 6fs; from a pace standpoint have a hard time seeing this gal being rushed to the lead with City Band sporting a similar style; watch and wait for another day.

Larkwhistle

Missed some time and the Mazarine due to a virus; has a home-court advantage, shown some quality while posting light Beyers; even had trouble when behind Storm Song in the Adirondack; good enough to beat this caliber, though? bred well as a half to \$122k earner Gygianno and \$187k earner Crafty Jam, raced well, but just doesn't seem fast enough at this time.

Dunbar Hill

Looks like a quality sort, even posted a 92 Beyer in breaking her maiden—and Wortheverycent came back to break her maiden by 5; but \$140k 2yo purchase isn't battle-tested gradedwise, broke her maiden without much trouble (recovered quickly after stumbling) after setting a modest pace; from a quality standpoint eye City Band's effort in the Oak Leaf 2 races later that day and make your own conclusion; all in all, this gal's speed vs. a ton of speed with actual limited mutuel value, big prior Beyer and all.

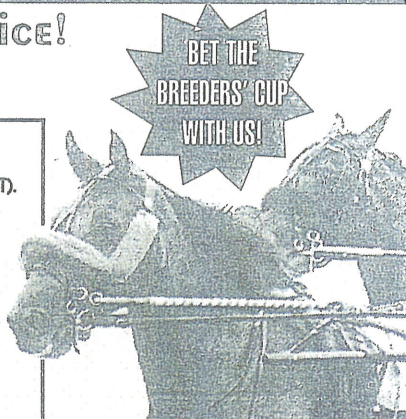

Iktamal

Shippers from Europe who have prospered in the Sprint are the exception rather than the rule; however, a couple who did perform well - Sheikh Albadou (won '91 Sprint) and Dayjur (unlucky 2nd in '90) - each competed at Haydock 2 races before the BC Sprint; layoff horses have good record in this race; half-bro to \$383,625 earner Rockamundo, who won the '93 Arkansas Derby at 108-1; guessing game as to how he'll handle dirt; in case track is wet, it's worth noting sire has good mud numbers (17% wins); like others more.

Lit De Justice

Equine rebel; gate crew should get double-time-and-a-half pay for dealing with this guy; on his good days, he resembles a gray tornado on the turn (turn times of :21-and-low-change!); capable of :11-and-change final furlong; comes from off pace, but all '96 wins have been at 6 furlongs or less; he set track record in 5 1/2-furlong El Conejo and, after a move that gave opponents windburn, was well in front at stretch call; made the biggest impact of any closer in last year's Sprint; should have an honest-to-fast pace in front of him; this will be his last race; Sahadi excels with horses coming off moderate layoffs; 3 of last 4 Sprint winners were away at least 7 weeks and 3 of last 4 made previous start in SoCal; he grabbed a quarter jogging last Wed., but Sahadi said "it's very minor"; potentially a juicy overlay in a race where favorites have struggled.

Lakota Brave

Sometimes comes out of the gate slower than a Zamboni; been last at start call in 5 of his previous 7 races; was outside of Criollito in the Ancient Title and closed under left-handed urging; each of trainer's prior 2 BC starters finished in the money - Fine Spirit was 3rd in '84 Juvenile Fillies and Bertrando was 2nd in '91 Juvenile; this one raced vs. Lit de Justice 3 times at Santa Anita this year and finished behind him twice; sprint division in West seemed to have less depth than sprint division in East this year; like others more in win pool; memo to exacta shooters: of the past 8 Sprint exactas, 5 have paid more than \$380.

Paying Dues

Fairly versatile in terms of running style, which could come in handy with 3 rockets filling the inside 3 slots in the gate; among several who has set a :43-and-change fraction and kept going; hasn't done much since returning from most recent layoff, though; some SoCal bettors have motto of "Sise at a price"; big work at Santa Anita last weekend, as only 2 of 53 Sat. moves at 5 furlongs were in :59 or faster; part of mutual field along with Jess C's Whirl; it's worth noting winner Desert Stormer and show horse Lit de Justice were part of the Sprint mutual field in '95.

I was a race they needed and both vaulted forward for the race that really mattered - this one; \$725k yearling purchase has 3 full siblings who are SWs; winning profile of this race is for closers as only 5 of the 12 winners even had the lead after 6fs; showed in his debut he can stalk; avg. winning Beyer for this race is 99, and he seems poised to move to that mark or even blast through it; formidable, maiden or not.

Has certain pluses and minuses on his card - first, owns a G1 win in his only start over this track, and heads into this in top form, coming off a good Meadowlands Cup win; also third in the Classic 2 years ago, which leads to his major negative: his inability to win at this distance in 6 tries, though he has run well; has a shot to run a big race here as one of 2 from the stable, and his trainer thinks he might now stretch his speed to this distance; one of many possibilities if Cigar doesn't run big.

Cigar
Not much to add to what has already been written about this great, consistent and professional champion; has solid :48 1/5 blowout in NY before shipping here; he had been training lightly the preceding couple of days due to the wet conditions at Belmont; Monday, Mott said all was well with the foot (right fore), and he feels the horse can turn it around; he had his major work on the 16th, and the light training could help to freshen him; remains strictly the horse to beat, and should he run a Cigar-like race, and with a fast track in prospect, Woodbine could have a new track record for 1 1/4 miles following the race.

One of the 2 sophomores in here who has been through the long Florida and Triple Crown grind; he comes off a much-improved effort in the JC Gold Cup following a poor race in the Woodbine Million; as is the case with Will's Way, he went into the Woodbine race following 2 hard and fast races at Saratoga and was eligible to bounce; showed signs of turning things around last time and doubt that Nick would have brought him back if he thought the track was to blame; expect another solid effort from one of the likely pacesetters, and he is not out of the question, as he could move back to his best.

Atticus

Trainer has been high on him for some time and he returned some of that good faith with a front-running victory in Kentucky on a speed-biased wet race track; untried at this distance and against G1 company on dirt, but he will run coupled with Dare and Go and that will likely hurt the price if you favored him and not the latter; had a nice work prior to his arrival but he gets the acid test for class, distance and pace on dirt; will most likely have a serious impact on the early running but unless the track is severely biased in favor of early speed, he is a big question mark.

Alphabet Soup

Has come back in top form since his poor effort in the SA Handicap and he was disqualified from his win in the Goodwood where he seemed to finish with something in reserve; what he must prove is his ability at the distance and against G1 company on a different track; does handle the wet going, and is one of many who will be on or close to the lead; barn has done well from limited opportunities here and has Dramatic Gold in the race, too; will not be disgraced as long as he handles the surface.

Tamayaz

The 3rd Ontario-bred arrived in very good order after a no-hitch trip and was out for a "steady canter" on the Taylor turf course Tuesday; work activity is expected to pick up some mid-week looking for something "faster" on Wednesday and a "blowout on Thursday"; trailed Cigar in the Dubai race but has shown promise on the dirt before and has since run close to Tamayaz on a couple of occasions; was well thought of after his first 2 Nad Al Sheba dirt wins, but has much to prove and will have to do better to prove it.
