1 3/16 MILES. (1.522) 118th Running THE PREAKNESS STAKES (Grade I). Purse \$500,000 Added. 3-year-olds. Scale weight 3-year-olds with an entry fee of \$5,000 to pass the entry box, starters to pay \$5,000 additional. All eligibility, entrance and starting fees to the winner with \$500,000 added of which 65% of all monies to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, and 5% to fourth. Weights: 126 lbs. (Fillies allowed five pounds.) Starters to be named through the entry box on Thursday, May 13, two days before the race by the usual time of closing. The Preakness field will be limited to fourteen (14) entries and shall be determined on the Thursday immediately preceding the day of the race. In the event that more than fourteen horses are properly nominated and pass through the entry box by the usual time of closing, the field shall be the fourteen horses that have accumulated the greatest career money earnings determined by the Racing Secretary. In application of the above-described rule each horse will be separately considered without regard to identity of its owner. In the event that the Racing Secretary determines that operation of the above-described rule results in two or more horses being qualified for the fourteenth position, the Racing Secretary shall select the fourteenth horse by lot. The above conditions notwithstanding, no horse which earns purse money in the Kentucky Derby shall be denied the opportunity to enter and start in the Preakness Stakes. If the rule described in this paragraph results in the exclusion of any horse, the \$5,000 entry fee previously paid will be refunded to the owner of said horse. A replica of the Woodlawn Vase will be presented to the winning owner to remain his or her personal property. Nominations to each and all of the Triple Crown race, the Kentucky Derby, The Preakness and The Belmont (the "Races") may be made only by payment of a single subscription fee to the Triple Crown Productions, Inc., as agent for Churchill Downs Incorporated, the Maryland Jockey Club and the New York Racing Association Inc. (The "Associations"). The subscription fee of 342 nominations received by January 16, 1993, is \$600 and for 25 nominations received by March 27, 1993, is \$4,500. (These fees are to be apportioned equally among the three Associations to be part of the total part of the total purse for each of the three races.) At any time prior to Closing for the Kentucky Derby, the additional nominations to all three races will be accepted and the nominee will be eligible for the Chrysler Triple Crown Challenge bonus, upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$150,000 to Churchill Downs Incorporated. Following the running of The Kentucky Derby, but at any time prior to Closing for the Preakness Stakes, horses may be nominated to the remaining Races but will not be eligible for the Chrysler Triple Crown Challenge bonus, upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$100,000 to the Maryland Jockey Club of Baltimore City, Inc. At any time prior to the Closing for the Belmont Stakes, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$50,000 to the New York Racing Association. All supplemental fees will be included in the purse distribution of the respective Races for which paid. Horses nominated by payment of supplementary fee ("Supplemental nominee") will not be allowed to enter any Race in which the maximum number of starters has otherwise been reached prior to the time of Closing. If the number of supplemental nominees exceed the number of available starting positions at Closing, the conditions of each respective Race will be applied to determine which supplemental nominees will be allowed to start in such Race. All nominees, supplemental or otherwise, will be requested to pay entry and starting fees for the Race or Races to which they have been nominated. Triple Crown Productions, Inc. is guaranteeing total earnings of \$5,000,000 to the owner of any horse which wins all of the 1993 Kentucky Derby, Preakness Stakes and Belmont Stakes races (the "Races") and is offering a \$1,000,000 bonus to the owner of a horse with the best, most consistent finishes in the Races. The "Triple Crown Challenge" monies will be paid to the owner of a horse which meets these criteria: 1. Finishes in all three Triple Crown Races as listed above; 2. Earns points by finishing first, second, third or fourth in at least one of the Triple Crown Races, and 3. Earns the highest number of points over the course of the three Races. Points are assigned for each race: Win-10, Place-5, Show-3, Fourth-1. In the event of a tie, the \$1 million bonus will be distributed equally among the top point-getters. In the event of a dead-heat, equal points will be awarded in full. For example, 10 points for each horse in a dead-heat to win. Triple Crown Productions Inc. will pay to the owner of a horse winning all of the Races that amount necessary to bring total earnings for the Triple Crown winner to \$5,000,000. The total will include the winner's purse distributed by each racing association; the \$1 million point bonus described above; and a further bonus guaranteed by Triple Crown Productions to reach \$5 million total. Triple Crown Productions will present the Triple Crown Trophy to the owner of a horse that sweeps the Kentucky Derby, Preakness Stakes and Belmont Stakes.

A CLOSER LOOK

PERSONAL HOPE

Only horse in Derby to be close early and live to tell about it, making race arguably as good as Santa Anita Derby. Hennig said not having raced in 30 days may have hurt a bit, and he'll certainly be tighter for this. Problem, however, is abundance of speed in field, coupled with his drawing the rail, a post which has not produced a Preakness winner in 30 years. He'll have to gun from the gate to avoid a shuffle, but he's the classiest by far of the speedballs. A must-use all the way around.

EL BAKAN

We know he likes to win and we know he's fast, but we're still clueless as to how far he can go in top-flight company. Had no chance from Post 19 in Derby, but stopped like he was shot before going six furlongs. It'll be interesting to watch what he does to Personal Hope early, and :47 3/5 drill means he'll be flying early. Still, hard to fathom him being within stone's throw of winner at wire.

ROCKAMUNDO

Will Dr. Jekyll or Mr. Hyde show up Saturday? Like the little girl with the curl, when he's good, he's very, very good, and when he's bad... We're only concerned with two things here—the fact that he's bred to run all day, and that his bullet half-mile drill Wednesday suggests the epiglottis surgery was successful. Prado for Borel jockey switch is a plus, and this horse has a license to improve more than any horse in the race if the epiglottis thing was significant. Beware.

SEA HERO

Yeah, yeah, yeah. Fool me once, shame on you, fool me twice shame on me. What did it for him in the Derby? A perfect, traffic-free trip off a hot pace? Second-time Lasix? Blinkers off? The cool temperature? The gods smiling on Mellon and Miller. His turf pedigree moving him up over a strip known to favor such breeding? Well, trips are left to fate; he runs sans Lasix here since he's never bled in a race; it could be well into the 70s on Saturday and his turf breeding won't do him an ounce of good this time around. Unless he's suddenly found himself, in which case I'm way off base, he seems a good horse to bet against. Throw in the bounce factor as well.

WILD GALE

Another who comes from far out of it, not the style we're looking for here even with the plethora of speed. Derby third was first rate, but then again, he may be a Churchill lover since the two best races of his career came over that track. Worked well over a lightning-quick Pimlico strip the other day, but looks more like a Belmont horse than a Preakness winner.

KOLUCTOO JIMMY AL

A neck away from an unblemished slate around two turns, but speed-laden gelding will have to learn to rate real fast with two main speed runners breaking from the inside. Earned a higher Beyer number winning the Cahill Road than Storm Tower did winning the Wood less than an hour later. Picks up 10 pounds, but also gains the services of McCarron—a wash. Trainer said primary goal was Belmont Stakes, so could this be a mile prep? Ability is there, but so are better spots.

CHEROKEE RUN

Only three setbacks in 11 starts, two by less than a length. He's here because of wins in the Lafayette and Derby Trial in Kentucky with Lasix, which he won't be using here. Of all the so-called speed horses in the race, this is one who may be able to rate. Has run 103 Beyer numbers in his last pair, and would only have to improve slightly Saturday to be right there at the finish. Just keep one thing in mind—he hasn't run a speed figure above 90 in his two-turn tries. Your move.

PRAIRIE BAYOU

We're still waiting for him to bounce or begin feeling the effects of grinding campaign that began in October without a break. Ultra-consistent gelding may have shown a hint of fatigue in Derby, however, when he failed to change leads until late. Plus, this race is rarely won by a horse who'll be as far back early as this one, and Smith won't be able to take him as wide on the turn as he's been doing. But the abundance of speed bodes well for his charge, and you'd be a fool to ignore him completely.

HEGAR

Not Sammy Hegar of Van Halen fame, not Hegar the Horrible, but Hegar the Everglades champ and winner of his last two starts. Was all out to win the Hialeah stake by a nose, and horse finishing second is still a maiden. Picks up 16 pounds and has never earned a Beyer number over 87 on the dirt. Trainer must have confused this race with the Never Bend earlier on the card.

TOO WILD

Not as ridiculous as Hegar, but then again, maybe Zito couldn't find a "non-winners of one other than" allowance for which this horse is still eligible. His highest Beyer number is 91, earned with a good second in the Cahill Road, but is picking up 13 pounds. He'll keep Prairie Bayou company early, about 15 lengths off the lead. The only difference is Prairie Bayou will wave bye-bye leaving the backstretch. Strike the Gold he ain't.

UNION CITY

Lukas thought his 22nd Derby starter was his best, that is until he hit the top of the stretch when he stopped on a dime. All accounts say this horse looks fabulous, but why no workouts since the Derby, unless he's working under the cover of darkness? Bottom line is that the Preakness is Lukas' best Triple Crown race, and he's been known to fire bullets following a dull Derby. In addition, if this horse runs a 105 Beyer like he did in the San Rafael, he's right with the best of 'em. He has the perfect style for the way this race shapes up (middle move); very, very sneaky.

WOODS OF WINDSOR

The obligatory Maryland horse faltered in his only race vs. top-flight company, but came back with a sterling effort in the Tesio over this track—in fact, this is the only horse with a race over the Pimlico strip. Lasix moved this horse up in a big way, and observers say he's the best-looking Preakness starter since Hansel, another son of Woodman. He's still learning but he may be peaking; a good bet underneath in exotics.
