PICK: 8 SUMMER FIREFLYS
 Robertson has two runners in here and both look as if they could be live. This one is ridden by Evans who has won 3 of 10 when on a 1ster for Robertson (two more ran second). The odds were 7-5, 6-1, 8-1 on the winners. Note a 46.3 gate drill. Check betting action.

PICK: 7 HUNTER'S MAGIC
 Bred for the turf on both sides of the family. She ran to the breeding in her first start with a huge late run to just got outnodded by another 1st timer. The dam won 313k on the grass (all routing). Makes a serious rider change to the '20 leading man. Can be any kind.

PICK: 2 BAYOU COLONEL
 Sib to 3YO colt for the same ownership, Bayou Gem. He won a MSW at CD back in May at this distance on the dirt. Debut came on the turf. He showed speed (21 flat) before tiring. Came back and worked quick in 45.4 best of 45 works (full second faster than 2nd).

VALUE: 9 HONEY BELLA
 Trainer Mac Robertson is 11 for 45 (24%) with 27 ITM (60%) with a first time 2YO sprinting on the dirt in a MSW here at CBY. Full sib to the \$364k winner Belle Tapisserie. Three other sibs won over \$100k in their career. Has a sharp gate drill here 10 days ago in 47.1.

VALUE: 2 LEFT OF CENTER
 Was last in the same race as the top choice and was just a few necks behind that one in a blanket finish. Has turf in the pedigree so stretching out here will be ideal for her. Prior turf start was not good (in the start 3 back) but she was coming off the layoff there.

VALUE: 5 TWISTED DIXIE
 Had a troubled trip in last at 11-1. He hopped at the start and then was shuffled back. He had a couple of decent efforts at OP vs. Ark-breds. Seems to be a bit better sprinting and he cuts back to a sprint in this one. Should be finishing late if the pace is fast.

PICK: 3 SUNDANCE STAR
 Stretches out for the first time here. She is in with a pretty soft bunch for a MSW and it is a good spot for her to try routing. Dam was all route (mostly turf) in her career. Sire won the Ky Derby. Should be near a slow early pace. Wins if she wants this added ground.

PICK: 10 DOODLE TIME
 Owners Novogratz with trainer Mac Robertson are 11 for 12 (92%) in the top two dropping from an alw to clm here at CBY (7 wins, 58%). 10 were Aug/Sep in prior years. This says they're dropping for a win before meets end. Obvious standout on class here.

PICK: 11 LOVE THE NEST
 Ran a big race in debut despite getting beat as the 3-5 favorite. He was in chase mode to a loose leader who was well-meant in the debut. It was far back to third. Dam was a two-time winner of the Mn Distaff Championship ('12 and '13). Cost \$105k as a Mn-bred.

VALUE: 6 TIMBER LADY
 Professional maiden has had 16 tries between dirt and turf. She does come running at the end and has a few starts that put her squarely in the win mix here today. Was less than a length behind Firemans Sis in her last start and was getting to that one. Must use.

VALUE: 9 WILLTOBELUCKY
 Last time on turf was two back. He was a longshot there but made matters worse with a stumble out of the gate. Efforts on the turf at TUP and HAW prior were not too bad. Has significant turf breeding on the female side (Kitten's Joy). Quinonez gets aboard.

VALUE: 5 HUNTER JUMPER
 This is a sibling to the exceptional Mn-bred sprinter Sky and Sea. She won her debut here in a MSW at 5F by 16 lengths and was a 4-time stakes winner some 5 or 6 years ago. You can not tell how a 1st timer will run from the works for Robertson. He can work slow.

The last time at this level was three back and she won over some in here. Been in top two in 4 of the 9 turf starts at CBY.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 Y NOT SIZZLE Last start at 5F was merely a prep for longer. She's been a long distance runner in So Cal so it appears Diodoro wanted to get a run into her before the 10 day break. Now she stretches out. Didn't disappoint there with a 7 length win. Flat at 6-5 two back with no real excuse. Stumbled at the start on a muddy track in last. Finally breaks away from the rail.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 GOLDEN GULLEY Shipped in from East Coast to try a Mn-bred stakes here last time out. That was a strong field there and he may not have loved the muddy track. The 2 who ran back won. He was a very decent 2nd to recent Victor Myers stakes winner Thealligatorhunter. Sharp win over a good MN-bred allowance field two back. Winner of last was one for Diodoro, was favored and earned career best Beyer.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 MISTER K Ships in from Churchill Downs when he was 7th vs. a 50k claiming group. He got away slowly from a wide post and couldn't recover enough finishing about 6 behind. Berndt has had success for Lothenbach on these shippers. Drew the 11 post in last start and was shuffled back out of the break. That was a strong MSW and this is a big class drop today.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 ROVERTON He was in that same deep MSW race last out that the top choice was out of. He drew the 10 post in there and broke first but quickly tired chasing a very fast pace. Best effort was going long three back and he gets that again here. That was his first start in nearly a year. Nibbled in tougher company at RP and RUI. Dam won 6 of her first 7 starts including the G1 Ruidoso Downs Fut in 2004 & earned 300k. Harr rode the trainers win here.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 CORONADO CROWN Ok-bred 3YO gelding has been a bit green in some of his four starts. Off slow two back at 8-1 and then ran evenly thereafter. Much improved start in last when a close third at this level at 12-1. Leading trainer and Valenzuela has won 24% for him here. She was finishing best of all in there to get into 4th beaten a half of a length. Might want a bit more distance but has proven to have some talent and class and will be tough with a clean break. Perfect fit in this race.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 JESS AN IVORY TOWER Trainer has had a sneaky good meet with 4 of 9 in the money. This one was a neck back in the debut at RP at 21-1.
