Casse gets 15% with a debut 2YO sprinting in MSW. Has very strong ELP drills.			Some things to like here. She comes in off a solid 3 rd last out at MTH. 4 th beaten 7 lengths was second beaten less than 1 length next in MSW at LRL (57 Beyer). Debut was at SAR on a muddy track where she did take action. Has a sizzling CDT workout and draws a top rider in Jose Ortiz.

Trainer Mark Casse finally cut him back to a sprint in the start two back at CNL and he won for fun at 10-1. The 2 nd place finisher returned to win a Va-bred 130k stakes on the turf at CNL. Was really moving late in the race in the Turf Sprint last out. This rider won a G2 aboard him in '21.

The last start was just too poor to be believed given her previous starts. She was 1-5 and was flat all the way for Gaffalione. She won the G2 Raven Run here and was 3rd in the BC F&M Sprint in the race after so we know she is ok with the surface. Gaffalione won 5 of 7 starts on her.

VALUE: 5 HAPPY SOUL

She ran second in this race last year which happens to be the last time she ran on dirt. She's 0 for 5 on turf but 5 for 6 in the top two on the dirt. Drew tough inside post positions at KD and SAR in the last two. Her style fits for the wider draw here. Blinkers on. She'll get a perfect trip.

Has some excuses in the losses. Kentucky Downs can be a track that some horses just don't take to. She was the 2-1 favorite there last out but the wide trip and surface wasn't to her liking. Hit the gate, off slow in the G1 Just a Game 3 back. Does have class. Will be finishing fastest.

Brad Cox is 2 for 8 w/ a 2nd timer in a G1 routing for 2YO's. All 8 would become G1 winners or G1 placed (the winners were superstars Essential Quality in this race in 2020 and British Idiom in the Alcibiades in 2019). The 88 Beyer is the 3rd fastest 2YO debut for Cox (best is Loggins, a 90).

VALUE: 8 NORTHERN FLAME

Has the look of an improving colt. The breeding is heavy to long distances so it might be that McPeck was taking his time bringing this one forward. Crushed when more ground was part of the equation last out. Notice it was over 6 clear to third. 2nd dam was G1 placed twice at BEL.

Had absolutely no trouble with the G1 Woodbine Mile in the last start. The runner-up is a classy sort who was 2nd in the G1 BC Mile last Nov and won the G1 Makers Mark earlier here last year. Nosed out in a G1 at 1M in '21 in a field of 14. Trainer Appleby has been tough in the US lately.

VALUE: 3 STITCHED

Turned into quite a turf runner. He's won 6 of 12 overall on the grass. Was a 46-1 upset winner two back in the G2 Wise Dan. Game runner-up in the rich G3 at KD last time out. Has speed but doesn't need to be on the lead to win here. Former mdn clm 30k runner is in career best form.

First time starter for a trainer who only gets about 9% in spots like this. But the sire Not This Time hits at a very high rate with debut 2YO's (20%). Not much to work with in the female line. Gelding has been working here since July and the works have been fantastic. Gaffalione is up.

VALUE: 9 WHO'S THE KING

Trainer Mark Casse gets about 15% with a debut 2YO in a MSW sprint race. Casse has had just one such starter in the past 3 years that was ridden by Rosario and that was a winner at KD at 4-1 odds. Another by the 20% first time 2YO sire Not This Time. Dam graded stakes placed.
