Tim Yakteen is 3 for 7 (43%) with a second time starter in a MSW sprinting on the dirt. 2 of the 3 wins were with one that was 5 th in the debut with a similar running line to this one. Those winners odds were 7-1 and 5-1. Debut was very decent at 17-1 when he closed in for 4 th from a wide post and a wide trip. Clockers really like the 2 works since last.			Going from Demuro to Irad Ortiz is worth lengths. She isn't that far off these as it is. She is going to be sitting behind the pace today and that is going to be the ideal spot. There is some speed to set up the closers. Did not have any luck 4 back when she was in tight and lacked room late in what was a bad trip. Toss last on good turf. Sitting on a big race.

Really moved forward in the second start when second to the Baffert-trained Provenance who since returned to run second in the Los Al Futurity. Third in that race was a Baffert who just ran second in a MSW on the turf.			She won three back pressing the pace to break her maiden at Del Mar. She was too close to the fast pace two back on this turf and rightly tired. The one she was dueling with in the early stages finished 10 th . They allowed her to sit back of the pace last out and she came flying to get beat a head at 13-1. Should be plenty of pace to set her up in this spot.

Draws the inside post and should be able to save ground. Never really trust LRC as not all runners handle that track. Place finisher two back won at this level next at DMR. 9 th won for 25k claiming. Only downside is both wins came with Lasix which he doesn't have today. Evenly matched stakes. VALUE: 7 MAAZ Willing to toss out the last start. He was on the rail and had the saddle slip in the early part of the race. The rider was able to keep it together but he lost valuable ground and then found himself far behind very slow fractions. Prior 2 starts are good enough to win this. Huge rider move to get Jose Ortiz. Figures to get a more honest pace to close into. Draws an ideal inside post for his style, and a repeat of recent races makes him tough to beat. VALUE: 7 BARTHOLDY Sprinter stretching out with an excellent speed rider Tyle Baze. The outside post almost ensures that they will send to take control of the early pace. Obviously the distance of this and the class are both going to be hurdles. VALUE: 1 SIMPLY JOKING Almost won the G2 Fantasy in her third start after winning back to back stakes to start her career. Fell apart in the G1 Ky Oaks and moved to Michael McCarthy after. Absolutely miserable trip in the G2 Raven Run. Pretty strong effort in the G3 last time out. Another who is cutting back some for this. Kimura up in the sharp last work. Trip will decide fate. Yet another with the blinkers off.

Jose Ortiz got back up in the last start and gamely won off the layoff. The runner-up from there came back to run third vs. similar. She has been working regularly at FG.
