Outran his 30-1 odds when a close 4th beaten just a length last out. It's worth noting that the 7th place finisher, Enahm, returned to run 3rd in front of both #1 and #4 in this race. He had quite a bit of trouble in the race at GG off the layoff two back. This rider knows him well. Drops back, will make one late run.

VALUE: 7 FORE FLAG
Same trainer as the top choice. He just got this one in his barn before the last start. That last race was terrible. He's run much better than that on turf in his career (10 of 19 in money). Interesting Rispoli gets up. He rode this one twice. He won once and was a close 3rd (both on the lead) in those 2 starts.

VALUE: 5 MANGO MOON
This is a glorified Los Alamitos hook race. Most of these have been running there lately. This filly is 2 for 2 here at Santa Anita. She's won times for this obscure outfit. In fact, those 3 wins were half the wins this trainer had in 2023. Runner-up and show in last start ran 1st and 2nd in a Los Al allowance Sat.

VALUE: 4 DRIVE FOR SHOW
This is a sibling to the 2015 Grade 1 Hopeful winner Ralis. That Reddam owned runner ran well on turf later in his career. Another sib, also for Reddam, won 185k on the grass as a sprint stakes winner in 2017. Cuts back in distance for the first time since the first start. Isn't facing much for a minor award.

Both claimed her lost her via the claim and claimed her back. Hasn't been out since November but encouraged to see top level jockey Rosario up. She adds Lasix for this. Steady set of drills. Sadler keeps her protected. Should fire here. He will be closing from off the pace.</p> <p>VALUE: 9 PETCOFF Set the pace in the same race the top choice exits. He stayed on for nearly all of the race and was 4th by less than a length. Huge rider change to Rosario and cuts back in distance. He's run well sprinting on the turf. Given his running style, 6.5F seems the right distance for him. Has a big win chance today. Best runner in the female family is Scott's Scoundrel, a 19-time stakes winner of \$1.3M from the late '90's. Just too tough to buck the Bob Baffert magic in So California.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 REVISED STATUTE Half sibling to Valiance. She won the G1 Spinster in 2020 for Todd Pletcher and then was 2nd in the G1 BC Distaff behind Monomoy Girl. Probably needs a race. Mandella rarely debuts going long and never starts a maiden first time vs. winners. Cost \$1.8M and has distance blood on both sides of the family. A) 2 B) 1,3,4 C) 5,6</p>

Looked sensational in the debut when she went wire to wire. Only won by a neck with Prat two back but they could've gone around again and the runner-up wasn't passing her. Prat normally up for D'Amato (has 3 here). Advantageous wide post.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 ANTIFONA First two starts routing in the US and she didn't get much pace to chase. That won't be a problem with the cutback in this spot. Was really bothered early and late in the stakes last out. She was completely shut off on the rail in midstretch and lost any real chance there. Wide post will keep her out of trouble. Dusted stablemate Dangerous Game (who is in this race) in the recent work. Alsagoor was up in the drill.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 DISOBEY Trainer did not win a race last year. But he finished in the money with 8 of his 13 starters. Winner of the last start was a neck away from winning 3 straight stakes after that win. Obviously the layoff along w/ the low percentage outfit is a major concern. He's worked consistent since Halloween. Check betting. Loves the distance and he'll get the run of the race sitting 4th behind the speed.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 GIOVINAZZO Ran a winning race in 3 of the last 4 starts. He has exceptional speed but might be in for an early fight with other speed in the race. If he gets loose from that speed he'll prove tough to reel in.
