He will need to move earlier to get there at the wire today.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 HI YAH Nothing wrong with the La-bred allowance win two back at 5-2 odds. The runner-up from that race won back in allowance. Last place finisher dropped to a 15k claimer and won. Steadied early in last and was 4-wide before going flat late. Rider won over 200 races in '23. Runner he beat in last had won a similar race by 9 previously and then crushed next for 15k at CBY. Robertson and this ownership have won 25% at OP at around this level. This one split the field at 8-1 in a decent run. She's been pretty consistent at this allw level. She's 6 for 9 in the money at the distance and 4 for 6 in the money for Asmussen. Trainer is 52 for 139 (37%) with 100 on the board (72%) for this owner in a dirt sprint when off at 5-1 or less. Career best came here a year ago.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 LIFE IS HARD Another one who ran a career best a year ago right here at OP with Tyler Baze aboard. Has had excuses since that win (turf, off-tracks, routes). Really bred on both sides to sprint and seems well-spotted in this spot. Rider has had a good meet so far. Should be in a prime spot tracking the pace. Asmussen is 20 for 50 (40%) with 37 in the money (74%) when in a dirt sprint stakes, 3YO only and off at 2-1 or less.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 GOOGOL JOKE Was off slow in the Renaissance won by the top pick last time out. He gathered himself, ended up with a wide trip and was passing runners in the lane for a third place finish at 17-1. Rider got to know him out of that start and is back here. Sharp 4F move on this surface. Bred to sprint. Excellent 4F work on Feb 3.</p> <p>VALUE: 11 TWO BELLS Took some action here in a MSW with Bejarano up in the debut. She got away poorly and never really was able to make up that ground. Encouraged that Bejarano sticks with her for a trainer who is better when a runner has a race under their belt. Bred to sprint. Adds first time Lasix.
