

ON THIS DATE – On this date in 1988, **FOURSTARDAVE** (at 22-1) outfinished 52-1 Hedever the Gold to win the \$300k G2 Saint Paul Derby. The favorite for D Wayne Lukas, Tejano, faded badly. The result capped off the largest pick 3 in Canterbury history with 22-1 Talc's Girl and 2-1 Lonely Beach. It paid \$51,030. That record still stands.

PICK: 3 SILENT SAILOR

Willing to give him the last race. That was turf routing in what is turning out to be a key race. Winner of that race won back in allowance at 5-1. Runner-up won in a MSW easily next. Winner two back was second in a 36k allw at 8-1 next. Biggest class drop in all of racing here.

PICK: 1 MAJOR ATTRACTION

Huge effort moving back to the turf for a trainer Matt Williams who has 5 of 9 in the exacta at the meet. That was a sharp win over weaker despite getting pushed out wide on the turn. Other turf win came routing in a MSW at AP in 2020. Will save ground from the rail draw.

PICK: 3 LOVELY LINDA

She should really have the easiest time getting to the front here. Two runners to her inside are deep closers and the one to her outside is a stablemate who wants to track off the pace. Last two times this one set early pace, she wired the field (3, 4 back at TUP). Pace edge.

VALUE: 1 DA GHOST

Have to hold your nose a bit to find the runner-up. This one beat two horses in four starts last year. Drops for this return start and picks up Lasix here. Really not all that bad of a worktab. Just needs a bit of improvement to make a dent in here. Trainer Rhone heating up lately.

VALUE: 4 PERFECT FANNY

Comes in off of back to back wins on the dirt at TUP w/ Harry Hernandez up in each. Ran well on the turf in the past including a win on this track. The 5th and 7th grass efforts here were odd. He normally has tactical speed but was back in both early. More forwardly placed today.

VALUE: 5 LYRICAL

This 4YO filly could end up being closest to the front in here outside the top choice. She faded in both starts since the claim 3 back but has run well enough to have a chance here in previous starts. Trainer has 4 wins at the meet and this rider was up for one of the wins (8-1).

PICK: 7 COME ON SWEET PEA

This 6YO mare has run 4 times on this turf. She won 2 of those starts and was 3rd in another. It took her a few starts to win off the break last year and same in 2020. Likely needed last and she ran pretty well getting he runner-up spot. Biehler is 2 for last 3 with rider Lara up.

PICK: 3 MAN U

Michael Biehler lost this one via the claim for 5k back in April 2021 but took him right back for 7k. He's had a lot of success with him. Sharper this year. Was a game runner-up to College Party who won back. Third won at 25-1 vs. better and 5th ran 2nd for 7k at 50-1 in next start.

PICK: 4 MY DOMINATOR

Good effort as the favorite in last when 3rd beaten just two lengths. Now stretches out to a distance where he is 0 for 2. Both of those starts were on sloppy tracks in 2021. He beat 20k Ark-bred company earlier this year at 14-1. Nice run for 2nd at 7-1 last start. In a good spot.

VALUE: 1 SWANAGE

She appears to be the main speed and the fact she has the rail, and breaks quickly, means she'll be the one in control of the pace. The early fractions in her last two starts (both on this turf) were legitimately fast and she dug in gamely in each. Runner-up won an allw last Sun.

VALUE: 7 ONE SON OF A CHIEF

Been in the exacta 11 of his last 12 and 14 of his last 16 starts. He beat a couple of these at Fonner Park back in May. Does his best running sitting just in behind the pace and might get the fractions he needs to make a run. He has been in the money 18 of 26 at the distance.

VALUE: 5 SMART CALL

He doesn't win out of turn (just 2 for 26) but has a win and longshot runner-up in his last 5 starts. Sprinted in the last start and got held up in traffic. Hopped at the start two back. This trainer has won here at 38-1 and 31-1 and ran 2nd here at 57-1, 25-1, 11-1 and 10-1 odds.

PICK: 1 SHEZONEZESTREET

Despite running in a field of 6 last time out, she had a very wide trip throughout. That caught up to her in the late stages as she tired. Does have Irish turf breeding in the pedigree that leads back to turf graded stakes placed Safety Catch who had 14 turf wins in the late '80's.

VALUE: 4 CLAIRE SAILING

Dam It's Tamereno won the '13 Princess Elaine Stakes on this turf course at 1M 1/16 and earned over 100k on the grass. She's beaten just 4 runners in 3 races so she has to improve to be a factor. Stumbled at the start in the last race. If she has any talent, she'll show it today.

PICK: 2 HARLOW'S HARMONY

2nd dam Plana Dance won 11 times on this turf course and was the champion filly here in '96. Dan was 2nd in the 2008 Princess Elaine on turf here. Trainer Michael Biehler started one time sprinting in a turf MSW and it was a win here last year at 4-1. This is a 42k purchase.

VALUE: 5 RUNNERS HEAT

This filly started once and it was here last Sep. It was a disaster as she was slow from the gate and was up the track by 31 lengths. Comes back with first time Lasix and a long and consistent worktab. Robertson has 3 in the race and his top call rider (Chirinos) ends up here.
