Shipper from PLN where he was last seen losing a head bob in optional claiming 25k. The winner was able to go very slow on the front and went wire to wire. This one was closing into those slow fractions. Despite a claiming tag drop, it's a rise in purse money from last by 5k. Is 4 for 4 in top 2 on the dirt.

VALUE: 2 STOP AND A TRES

Stretches out and draws towards the inside. That might put him right on the lead today. He's won 2 of 3 starts going this 1M distance and is 5 for 12 in the exacta on a fast dirt track. Rider was up for the 7-2 win at Santa Anita two back. Seems like the way this race will shape up early will give him an edge.

Bob Baffert is 24 for 45 (53%) with 39 in the money (87%) in a MSW sprinting on the dirt at Del Mar for 2YO's when off at 2-1 or less. This is the female family of the 1993 Kentucky Derby winner, Sea Hero. Dam was a stakes winner sprinting on the turf. Might be better down the line with some ground.

VALUE: 2 SMASH IT

High percentage trainer brought this La-bred into So Cal in middle June from working in New Mexico and was a solid 2nd place finisher behind a very well meant Bob Baffert first time starter (who hasn't run back yet). Dam won 7 of 8 for Fincher and a sibling (Slammed) crushed in a G2 for Fincher last Oct.

Trainer Hess and rider Desormeaux have teamed up for a lot of wins at Del Mar over the years. Many have been for these owners. Thought the opt clm 80k race he comes out of was a very strong race. Only one to have run back was the 3rd place finisher who ran 2nd in the 100k Bertrando at LRC next start.

VALUE: 10 EDDIE'S LAST

O'Neill moved him back to turf sprints on the comeback last November. He's been in the money in 6 of 7 since (lone race off the board was a 5th place finish beaten less than 2). He's a Cal-bred so he qualifies for this race having won last time out in a Cal-bred race. Should be one of the deepest closers.

He has been gelded since the last start and the connections decide to keep him protected even though they could likely drop him and not risk claim. Has shown talent that led to a try in the G1 Santa Anita Derby last year. The winner had nibbled in G1. Turfy pedigree with turf influence Manila in the backbreeding.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 CHARM YOUR WORLD The female line has produced some very solid runners. Most were trained and owned by McAnally. Sib, Rock Your World, won the 2021 Santa Anita Derby and was the 2nd favorite in the Kentucky Derby. Really like the quality and spacing of the works heading into this. That includes his last such starter (Kopion) who was also by the sire Omaha Beach. He is normally a more patient trainer so it's likely this one is going to be better later. Note a sizzling 4F move at SA on July 4th.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 AMERICA'S MARK Trainer Steven Specht is 6 for 13 (46%) with 11 in the money (85%) with a \$3.51 ROI when starting a first time 2YO MSW in a sprint for this ownership. Unlucky to lose a stakes at SA 3 back when he had a bit of trouble early. Was just a head back there. Maintains a top level rider Hernandez.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 FORMIDABLE MAN This is a Frances Genter (owner of Ky Derby winner Unbridled from 1990) backbreeding leading to the superstar, Met Mile winner In Reality. Dam was a G1 turf router who earned over 500k in her career. 3 next out stakes winners from the start two back. Winner just won the G1 Belmont Derby. Steadied badly in the mid part of the race. Blazing works since. Will be more professional.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 WAYNE THE BRAIN Sire won 10 of 14, \$3.1M and the 2019 BC Sprint. This one has a bit of a turf pedigree on the female side. Trainer Mark Glatt is 8 for 29 (28%) with a first time MSW in a dirt sprint for 3YO's and older. Have to take notice of the 1:12.4 work for 6F at SA two weeks ago. Had major traffic issues 3 and 4 back which likely cost her each time as the favorite. Off slow two back at 6-5 odds. VALUE: 4 NAVY MAN

Early pace and position will play a bit part in who wins in this spot. 4YO was a 475k purchase in 2021 and the connections gelded him after the last two rather poor starts. Worth noting Hernandez lands here when he could've ridden others in this race. That maiden win would be the race that would take this.

Clearly a prep for this one as he sat well behind a very slow pace and ran on late. Sib Amy's Challenge was a G1 type.

VALUE: 8 ROSTOVSKY

Connections had this one sprinting in a 50k claimer in debut at SA. He outran the 17-1 odds even though he had trouble in the race. Broke slow in last but came on late to get within two lengths in the end. Mark Glatt put in 5 well-spaced works since last. Eligible to improve. The 3rd start in the form cycle.

Think both races were preps for this spot. Winner 2 back won a 100k stakes on turf next. Sitting on a big run here.

VALUE: 11 WAR PAINTER

This is a stakes winner on the turf. Her only poor race so far in her career came against male runners on a good turf four starts ago. Absolutely crushed in the betting in the last two starts. Comes into this with some excellent works. Bred for the long distances. Gets an excellent rider for this rich stakes.
