At any time prior to the closing time of entries, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$100,000 to the New York Racing Association, Inc. \$10,000 to pass the entry box and \$10,000 additional to start. All entrants will be required to pay entry and starting fees; but no fees, supplemental or otherwise shall be added to the purse. A CLOSER LOOK

Master of Hounds

Weather could be a factor with early prediction of 50-50 chance of rain and that could change the complexion of the race if some don't handle the going; this guy and has every right to improve after getting a taste of racing stateside on dirt; he was left with too much work to do in the Kentucky Derby when 15th early but instead of just throwing in the towel, he finished with interest and was getting to the winner late; he should adore the trip, but he also may have to show the agility to move in traffic; got to figure he'll be making a move in the final furlong.

Stay Thirsty

Don't be shocked if he is more involved early today; he was down inside in the Derby, never the most comfortable spot; he trained fast since beating only 7 at Churchill and would not be shocked if he is put into the race earlier this time; he has the pedigree to run till the cows come home; don't be taken by surprise if he runs huge here.

Ruler On Ice

Only one off effort and he could have been green for that debut; has taken a strange road to Belmont earning his only Graded cash at Sunland Park; the runner picked up a couple of lengths late in the Tesio and the value will be there but who was he facing?; the winner of the Tesio was crushed at 25-1 in the Preakness; not sold on chances.

Santiva

Far from disgraced last time, colt is coming off a career Beyer figure and if you toss his effort at Keeneland when they went super slow early and he lacked room, the form looks much better; in very good hands, with anything close to an honest pace, this guy could be making some huge strides in the final furlong.

The name certainly doesn't fit as he has zero speed in reality; once he was sent long, he started to figure it out; yet another of the deep closers in here today, he was hung out to dry at Churchill and love the series of drills coming to today's test; could easily be enticed into gimmick action.

Nehro

Cozier slot after breaking from the 18 hole at Churchill; made a looping more to reach contention at Churchill, but then was swallowed up by Animal Kingdom; one of the best things he has going for him is that he has been rested since the Derby and has a shot to put in a peak performance; he got a feel of the surface last Monday and worked inside of stablemate and Derby Trial 2nd in the 5/30 drill when both runners recorded same time; right on the wire with the A game.

Monzon

Long-fused runner has beaten some short fields; this is a whole new ballgame rather than whipping those Count Fleet foes; the trip should not bother him as his sire won this race; could envision a trip will he will sit mid-pack early, hoping somebody is pushing Shackelford to the limit up front; things need to unfold just right.

Prime Cut

Soph broke in the air in the debut but has been live in every other race; ability to show tactical speed is one of his advantages in pretty much a pacesetter race other than the outside rival; he had aim late in the Peter Pan, just could not close the deal; figures to at least middle the pace a bit.

Animal Kingdom
Logic says the Derby hero will adore the distance of this classic; he has fired every single time and was flying at the end of the Preakness; the concern is that this has been a grueling campaign and you don't quite know how much is left in the tank; would like to see this guy a little closer early and he has shown the ability to track close in that maiden breaker; he is a fitting chalk and there is no reason why he won't be picking them up and laying them down in the lane.

Mucho Macho Man
Wide and in tight in the last pair, colt has trained fast for this but he has had a tough series of races and had every right to rally last time and could not pull the trigger; the best of 15 bullet last Sunday of :59.57 was better than the second best of 1:00.04 posted by Holy Ego, who took a \$25K N2L fray here last month and entered in the 5th race today; looking elsewhere for a key top horse.

Isn't He Perfect
Expect a huge number here; runner has never been in the money in any of his stakes efforts and was a non-factor in Baltimore; only one win this year and he was able to control a moderate pace; that won't happen here and the horse that ran 2nd in that March 20 race was coming off a score in a cheap maiden \$12.5K claimer; will need to be more than perfect.

Shackleford
The feeling is the post will not hurt him too much here; his connections and the rider must decide how to utilize his speed; should they just gun hard and try to outrun them off their feet or should they play cute and slow down the splits and try to lull the closers to sleep?; his trainer had this to say early in the week: Romans: "I don't think post will decide the race, you've got a mile and a half to sort it out"; he indicated that the post might cause his runner "to be sent a little more anyway, just to make sure he clears"; as his trainer is fond of saying, he's got a high cruising speed and he has a right to take to an off track if that presents itself; whatever the case or the strategy, catch this guy to cash.
