RISEN STAR raced in closest attendance to WINNING COLORS while remaining well out in the track and was still in hand while moving up outside that rival before going six furlongs. RISEN STAR headed WINNING COLORS racing into the turn, quickly drew off approaching the stretch and continued to increase his advantage while being shown the whip several times. KINGPOST, never far back while racing well out in the track, moved closer to the leaders nearing the end of the backstretch, remained a factor to the stretch but was no match for the winner while holding sway for the place. BRIAN'S TIME commenced to rally approaching the far turn but lacked a further response. CEFIS, badly outrun for a mile while saving ground, failed to reach contention. GRANACUS was always outrun. WINNING COLORS broke in front, remained well out from the rail while making the pace, held on well for just over a mile and stopped badly.
