The winner of that race ran second in the Monmouth Oaks next. Would think a Liam's Map out of a Giant's Causeway dam would prefer the dirt. Her first on a fast dirt track. VALUE: 6 HARMONIQUE Last time she ran on this Del Mar dirt course was against males when she was third to a future G2 winner. Did little in New York afterwards and shipped back to So Cal for her last start. It came in a dirt sprint. She is bred to go long so she should relish a move to this distance. Drysdale teamed up for a win with Rosario last Sunday at 9-2 odds. Doubt we've seen her best yet. Square price. That includes a tough luck runner-up finish on Sunday beaten a neck for the same ownership. These works are better than that runner-up had going into her race here last Sun. VALUE: 1 DANG SON This is one of two in the race for Doug O'Neill and Calumet Farm ownership. This one comes from the female line that produced Pulpit (1997 Fountain of Youth and Blue Grass winner). There is not much turf in the pedigree so it remains to be seen if he likes this surface. Sire Good Magic also known for dirt (Mage, Dornoch) but does have 11% winners turf routing (is the national average). The 86 Beyer that she earned was the highest debut Beyer by a Puype firster in, at least, the last 5 years. 5 of the 7 behind her came back to hit the board (runner-up won at the same level). Probably has physical issues (didn't debut until the age of 4). Perfectly spotted in here.

VALUE: 7 BOURBON AND SPICE

Worth consideration for top honors in here. She's only been on a fast dirt course once (third at 9-1 in a MSW at Indiana). She has been ridden by an apprentice rider for all five of her starts and is now with one of the top riders here, Rosario. Privately sold after her last start in June. Has a decently spaced worktab. 5th beaten 16 in the last start dropped to 10k claiming and won by 6 (77 fig).

It was one day from exactly one year ago that this mare won on this turf, at this distance, at 7-1. She hit the shelf afterwards and nibbled in two opt clm races. Despite not hitting the board in the two races off the layoff, McCarthy has this one in a stakes. Most recent race was a strong opt clm 100k. Has been showing she is at her best with more distance. She may be sitting on a big race.

VALUE: 6 RESOLVE

She clearly has done her better running from behind. Last win three back came closing from last in the only start that Rosario was aboard. Last rider Hernandez pushed her into a very fast pace at 1M on this turf and she rightly tired late. Unlucky to have lost three straight in photo finishes. One of them was in a G3 at Santa Anita. Will get the best trip today.

If Jaramillo doesn't send with the filly to this one's outside, this is going to be a clear leader in the race. She's won many times in races when she has been the controlling speed. She is 3 for 6 at 1M on the grass and is the defending champion in this race. Toss the last start as she was cutting back and didn't get into the race early and was very wide on the dirt. Big rider move to Hernandez.

VALUE: 9 WINK AND A GRIN

One of two in the race for Carla Gaines. Have to look at the most recent start as a prep for longer. She broke from 11 post and did not do a lot of running until very late in the race. She now goes long in this stakes. She was a decent fourth in this race in 2025 at 5-1. One of her two wins have come at the distance. Has two works since last and the turf move was very good. Expect more.

This is, by far, the most likely winner but, by no means, any sure thing. He ran once and laid off 10-months. There was an attempt to claim him in the second start but that claim was voided by the vets. Layoff, run, layoff and drop. All not exactly a good sign. Having said that, he's faced and beaten much, much better in Kentucky. Would use but spread here.

VALUE: 2 ATTACK NOW

The connections claimed him for Del Mar. He was taken two back for 20k and they dropped him to this 16k level in next start (which was a month ago). He had a miserable trip as a 7-2 chance in there and really did not have a serious chance to win. Blinkers off. He was second in a MSW at LRC the last time he ran without them on dirt. Jaramillo is riding another.

Between the dam and sib (Hope Road) Bob Baffert had 12 wins and 18 in the money from 20 starts with this female line. Both of those were for this owner. Baffert has 7 wins and a placing from his last 8 debut 2YO's on dirt in MSW sprinting. In the last 3 years, Baffert is 19 for 32 (59%) with a debut 2YO MSW on dirt at DMR with JJ Hernandez. He's been working since April. Should be fit.

VALUE: 8 DOMENICI

Trainer Tim Yakteen has a good record with debut 2YO's here at Del Mar sprinting on the dirt in a MSW race. He is 6 for 25 (24%) with 10 in the money and an ROI of \$6.99. Sire Early Voting who won the G1 Preakness for Chad Brown is already 6 for 21 with a first time 2YO. There were some nice winners in there (3 of the 6 winners had an 80+ Beyer). Dam won a MSW at KEE in the debut.

It was also the first start with Rosario riding and he got this one to relax nicely before getting home late. The runner-up was clear of the rest of the field. Clockers liked the work on the dirt since.

VALUE: 8 BEYOND STOKED

Shipper from Churchill Downs. Those races in Kentucky are a lot tougher than the similar races in So Cal. Something went wrong 4 back when he eased as the favorite and was taken off in an equine ambulance. High percentage outfit looking for a DMR win. This one has backclass and both of his wins came on turf at this distance. An improvement here.
