## A CLOSER LOOK

### 11TH BELMONT

#### Frac Daddy

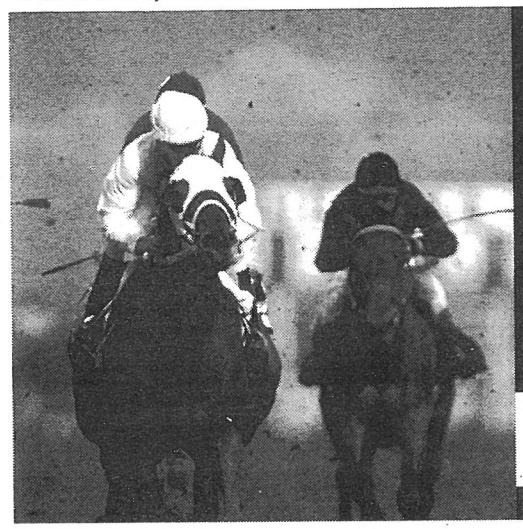
Late runner returns to the scene of his debut placing after failing to offer much in the sloppy Kentucky Derby 5 weeks ago; barn won this race 11 years ago with Sarava and his pilot stole the heat on the front end in 2000 with Da' Tara; added ground could benefit him, but he's been handled rather easily by some of these this year and will need to show up with quite a bit more to have a say in the outcome.

#### Freedom Child

Drew the fence and never looked back after making the lead over sloppy footing in the G2 Peter Pan here last month, earning a career best Beyer in the process; maybe the effort is an indication he's now ready for bigger and better things or it could be that he's just a different animal when he's allowed to have things his own way on the front end; he's worked in the interim like he maintains his sharp form and from this inside draw may be he's again able to make the lead but if he is he'll have a much stronger bunch looking to come after him than he did last time while tackling a significant amount of added ground today.

#### Overanalyze

Looked to get back on track in taking the G1 Arkansas Derby, but the figure came back pretty light and the big number he earned in the G2 Remsen last fall began to look more like the aberration; had some trouble in the Derby slop but he really didn't do much running but it does appear as if he'll stay the trip for a trainer/jockey combo that won this heat's 2007 renewal with filly Rags to Riches; Velazquez also won last year's Belmont with Union Rags; he took a G2 stake in his lone start here last fall and is working well for his local return so maybe he's able to get in the mix for a share of this.

Giant Finish

New York bred was ok out of restricted company over synthetic footing in Kentucky but he's another who didn't do much running in the Derby; his rider is a 2 time Belmont winner having taken it with Sarava and then Birdstone in 2004; he has only run a handful of times and is eligible to improve with experience but it looks as if he has a long way to go in order to threaten some of these.

Orb

As bold as this Derby winner looked in Kentucky is about as dull as he was in the Preaknees in Baltimore, but he was stuck down on the fence for a good part of the heat while looking to run at a pacesetter who had things his own way through easy splits in that odds on defeat; off the pace type did run off 5 straight prior to that one and it certainly appears as if he'll handle the added ground in a heat that his paternal grandsire won over 20 years ago; barn won this race in 1989 with Easy Goer; with just an honest clip in front of him this time he appears to be in line to get back on track for a barn that doesn't rush its runners to the starting gate; they'll have him to beat.

Incognito

Gray was on the improve before running into the free running Freedom Child over the sloppy going in the Peter Pan last month; his sire is a Belmont Stakes winner and the barn won this heat in 2006 with Jazil; he appears to like routing and maybe a return to dry footing would help, but don't know that he's good enough to go with these prime time runners right now.

Oxbow

Preakness winner had things his own way while wiring the field in Baltimore and now he'll tackle the added ground which he's bred to appreciate; he's proven he can run fast given the proper circumstances, but don't know that he'll be able to dictate the fractions today and without that advantage he's been rather ordinary; his pilot has won the Belmont Stakes 3 times, most recently in 2001 with Point Given and the Lukas barn last won this heat in 2000 with Commendable after running off 3 straight with Tabasco Cat, Thunder Gulch (Stevens aboard) and Editor's Note in the mid '90s; prefer to side against the repeat and limit his use to underneath in exotics.
