Joe Sharp is 7 for 24 off the claim this year with 14 of the 24 running either first or second. This could turn out a nice claim after this one was beaten a neck in a key race in the last start. The top two finishers both won opt clm here at TP next. Two others from that race hit the board in 30k clm next. Only his second time on Lasix in the last three years.		He had a bit of a hidden bad trip in the last start. He was a 6-5 favorite in there and was on the rail for the early part of the race. A runner was stopping on the turn and backed up into him forcing this one to drop back to near last into the lane. He did finish pretty well. Blinkers on. Good draw in the 5 hole. Trainer 4 for 8 at the meet. Will rebound here.

The fact she didn't return and comes back with Lasix indicates she might've bled. Been working since the middle of December. Has turf and synthetic breeding.		Only been on Lasix twice. The first time was in the maiden win at CD for 100k claiming when he went wire to wire as a 13-1 chance. He earned a career best 88 Beyer. The last race he was back on Lasix and ran well when passing many late to get up for third while wide. Blinkers are added for the first time. Has another bullet work since the last start.		Trainer Graham Motion is 13 for 56 (23%) with 33 that ran in the money (59%) and a positive \$2.39 ROI when he has one going sprint to route in the second start in a MSW. This one ran pretty well in the debut at 10-1 when beaten 7 with a wide trip. Full sib to the stakes winner Memorialize (also for Motion). He won his second start (also sprint to route).

In that filter, when you add Irad Ortiz, Cox is 3 for 4. Exits a strong race. 5th from there won the 200k Battaglia. The runner-up was 2nd in that very same stakes.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 EAST VILLAGE Have to think this colt had no interest in the sloppy track he was on last time out at CD. The starts previously, on the grass, were good enough to compete in this. Comes here with a perfect worktab for a trainer who does well in these kind of stakes with moderate runners. He has bullet works at Payson Park</p> <p>VALUE: 1 SMALL TOWN For those that play Beyer Speed Figures, this one has the second best Beyer in the field (debut win with an 81 figure at this distance). Speightstown on the top of the pedigree indicates sprinting so the move back to a sprint in the third career start is ideal. McCarthy has a main go-to rider from So Cal aboard, Kimura. Wise guy horse in the 2024 Kentucky Derby. He was under 15-1 that day and ran a non-threatening 8th with trouble in the early stages. He's won two stakes since then. One was last out in an easy 7-1 romp from off the pace. He should get some speed to run into here. Notice JD Ramos normally rides Mercante but opts for this one instead. Will be flying.

VALUE: 2 UTAH BEACH

Cheminaud is back up on this one. He's ridden him 6 times in his career. Those 6 races produced two wins and three more finishing second. Went out early in the last start but that really isn't his style. Last time on firm turf was in the G1 Sword Dancer 3 back when a credible 6th at 11-1 odds. Think he started to run too late in this race when 4th last year.

Shipper from Southern California. She's run 8 times with 2 wins including the Blue Northerner two back. She really ran well in there overcoming major traffic to get up for the win. Not easy to win from the inside going 6.5F especially on a cutback like she tried last time out. Kimura rode her in 6 straight to start her career. She was 2x graded placed.

Richard Mandella doesn't venture out of California often for a stakes. He's done it 11 times in the last 5 year and he won 4 of them and was second in another. The winners off at 12-1, 10-1, 5-1 and 3-1. This one got zero help from the post draws in 4 of the last 5 starts. Was working in sizzling fashion before a nose defeat last out. He's here for a reason.

VALUE: 4 TWO OUT HERO

He was 4-1 in the Battaglia so there were expectations in that race off the layoff. He stumbled quite badly from the widest 11 post and didn't appear to love the kickback he was getting throughout. Never won routing and both wins came on Lasix. But he is bred to go long and certainly can make amends for the last start. A bullet work entering this.

Trainer Paulo Lobo has big numbers with debut runners at this track. He's 36% overall but 44% when in MSW sprints with a first timer. He trained two of the siblings to this one and both of them won in debut here (None de Plume back in 2022 and My Buddy B, now a graded stakes winner, won in debut also in '22). This rider is 28% for Lobo here at TP.

VALUE: 10 FETCHMYDIAMONDS

Debut came at Keeneland back in April when with Wayne Catalano. She split the 10-horse field at 25-1. That race is turning out to be a key one. 1st, 3rd and 6th all won next out (winner won the G1 Alcibiades before DQ to second). This trainer is just 3 for 62 (5%) and hasn't won since 2024. So demand value. Check the toteboard for any betting action.
